Here are the figures concerning the past and future estimates of production and need: In 1950 we had 150,697,361 people, 12.5 acres per capita and 3.1 acres of cropland per capita. In 1975 apparent trends show an approximate population of 228,000,000 people, 8.3 acres of land and 2.2 acres of cropland per capita. These figures take into consideration the future reclamation of about 50,000,000 acres of swampland and difficult terrain.






