＂THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX
IN PAYMENT THEREOF
The word＂FOR＂and beneath it the word＂AGAINST＂shall be ade to appear on the left of the proposition．A square shall be each elector shall place and＂X＂in the square beside the statemen indicating the way he wishes to vote．

SECTION 4：That all resident qualified electors of the District shall be permitted to vote at said election．In addition this election shall be conducted and held in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code except as modified by the provisions of the Texas Education Code；and as may be required by printed in both English and Spanish

SECTION 5：A substantial copy of this order
shall serve as proper notice of said election，and said notice， including a Spanish translation thereor，shall be published one time at least ten（10）days prior to the date set for the election
in a newspaper of general circulation in the District．
