

Rogers Says Win Friends

TULIA, Tex. (AP)—Rep. Walter Rogers of Pampa, discounting Republican claims of "expectancy," said Tuesday night "what we need is a man who can gain friends and keep the ones we've got."

Rogers, who along with Rep. Jim Wright of Fort Worth addressed a group of 300 Democrats in this West Texas community, said the Republicans' experience consists of "alienating people and nations."

Or hand for the Democratic drum, beating, despite damp, chilly weather, were delegations from about half the counties in the 30th Senatorial District.

Wright told the audience the Democratic party is the safest custodian of the people's welfare. He said the crowd here was "bigger than the crowd that turned out in Dallas recently to hear a former governor speak to a Republican rally."

Wright emphasized the importance to Texans to have a Democratic administration to work with the Texas delegation in Congress.

He decried the tendency toward "big business, big firms, big spending by government during the Republican administration."

He said the Democrats favor a broader prosperity and more opportunity.

Nixon Called In Tax Case

LITTLETON, N.H. (AP)—Subpoenas are out today for Vice President Richard M. Nixon, Republican presidential candidate, and Sen. Norris Cotton, R-N.H., wanted as defense witnesses in a federal court income tax trial.

They were issued Tuesday night at the behest of counsel for Mark Granite, 78, director of the non-profit, tax-exempt Granite Foundation in Lancaster.

Attorney Thomas E. Flynn Jr. sought appearance of Nixon and Cotton after failing in attempts to introduce letters in which, according to testimony, they complimented Granite.

Herbert Klein, Nixon's press secretary, indicated there will be no comment until Nixon is served with the subpoena.

Judge A. J. Connor ruled the letters could be introduced only through the writers or recipient. This can be done after the defense opens if Granite takes the stand.

According to testimony of Richard J. Ryan, investigator for the Internal Revenue Service and chief prosecution witness, Granite told him the foundation received a quarter of a million dollars in contributions in 14 years. The government contends Granite diverted Foundation funds to his own use and that this is taxable.

Specifically he is accused of failing to report income of \$60,000 in a four-year period.

Weather-vane Areas Show A Close Race

WASHINGTON (AP)—The closest presidential election since 1916 may be in the making if the apparent trend in eight Weather-vane counties is maintained.

Each of the eight counties, strung across the nation from New Hampshire to Oregon, has voted consistently for the winning presidential candidate for more than a half century.

An Associated Press survey of the best available political opinion at this time gives three counties to Vice President Richard M. Nixon and three to his Democratic rival, Sen. John F. Kennedy. Two are regarded as undecided.

If this trend is followed in the Nov. 8 voting some of the guinea pig counties are going to lose their attraction for the dopesters.

But if their division represents a true picture of the national situation, the contest between Nixon and Kennedy could rival that of 1916, when Woodrow Wilson beat Charles Evans Hughes by a little more than 600,000 popular votes and 275 to 254 electoral votes.

With the election only three weeks away, there appears to be no overriding issue. Foreign policy, farm prices and Kennedy's Roman Catholic religion are among matters voters mentioned. But no clear trend was established.

September Called Drier Than Usual

AUSTIN (AP) — September was drier than usual in most of Texas, the State Board of Water Engineers said Tuesday.

Amarillo has had 10 inches more rain than normal, 31.20 inches, while Galveston on the Gulf Coast, has had only 16.17 inches this year, 17.43 inches below normal.

Other significant departures in rainfall for the year include Austin, a drop of 9.73 inches; Fort Worth, a drop of 7.98 inches; Port Arthur-Beaumont, a drop of 6.92 inches; San Angelo, 6.17 inches below normal; and Waco, 9.16 inches below normal.

In eight selected observation wells, three recorded water level rises ranging from 0.19 foot to 1.83 feet and the others recorded declines of 0.1 foot to 14.3 feet. The 14 foot decline was noted at the well near Batesville. A decline of 3.45 feet was recorded for the San Antonio well while the largest increase was reported at Brundage.

Runoff was below average for September. Flow of the Lower Colorado, Brazos and Trinity Rivers was partly maintained by releases from reservoirs.

The flow of the Canadian River near Amarillo was about 42 per cent of the September average. Small rises occurred on the Sulphur and Upper Sabine Rivers near the end of the month. The flow of the Trinity at Dallas was about 150 cubic feet a second, somewhat below average.

BURBANK, Calif. (AP) — A young widow spoke with her eyes Tuesday and helped undo the plot of a man who had kidnaped her baby daughter, the FBI reported.

Betty Utterback, 21, said a man she met on a blind date a week earlier stopped by her home and asked to take her 21-month-old daughter Cynthia on a shopping trip with him. He left with the child, she said, but returned 15 minutes later without Cynthia and demanded \$8,500 for her return.

Then, Mrs. Utterback said, the man forced her to accompany him to her bank and stood near her as she asked to make a withdrawal.

"She gave me a sign with her eyes that something was wrong," said Barney L. Kotrbe, the bank operations officer. Kotrbe said he gave a sign to another employee, who called the FBI. Agents seized James E. Reinhardt, as he was leaving the bank with Mrs. Utterback.

Cynthia was found crying and hungry in a motel room. Reinhardt, 24, of Ventura, Calif., was booked on suspicion of kidnaping.

Cuba May Seize Rest Of Property In U.S. Spite

HAVANA, Cuba (AP)—The confiscation of all remaining U. S. holdings in Cuba is considered certain to follow the imposition of new U. S. economic measures against Fidel Castro's regime.

Washington's embargo on almost all U. S. exports to Cuba, expected to be announced today, may also result in a formal Cuban demand that the United States abandon its huge Guantanamo naval base in easternmost Cuba. Castro may even break off diplomatic relations.

Castro told the nation last week American business here that were still untouched were being saved for expropriation if the United States committed "future aggressions."

The value of some 350 small firms in Cuba still in American hands is estimated at about \$250 million. The Castro regime already has gobbled up the big U. S. holdings, worth nearly a billion dollars.

At the United Nations last month the Cuban prime minister said his country was seriously considering a demand—via legal channels—that the United States quit Guantanamo. Observers here were puzzled when a quick follow-up did not develop.
