Experts predict that crude

gas prices may fluctuate as much as gas prices may fluctuate as much as
dime per gallon，the inflatio

predicted to drop 14.3 per cent during
1982 ，and 2.1 per cent in 1983 ． The price of Saudi Arabian crude
oil has dropped from a level of $\$ 40$
per barrel a year ago to $\$ 34$ at the per barrel a year ago

While this may be good news to motorists，farmers and other
consumes，the domestic oil industry
has been thrown into chaos．Where

The increased activity had been
