Move To Tap ERP Till For Arms Aid Grows In Senate

WASHINGTON —(P)—A move gained headway in the Senate Friday to tap European Recovery Funds for part of the \$1,000,000,000 cost of re-arming Western Europe. Members of the Senate Appropriations Committee are studying a possible amendment to the Economic Cooperation Administration (ECA) Act to lift some of the arms burden from the American taxpayer. The idea first was proposed by Senator Lodge (R-Mass.), who works closely in foreign affairs with Republican Senator Vandenberg of Michigan. It has been picking up support, despite opposition from ECA Chief Paul Hoffman. Senator Knowland (R-Calif.) said Appropriations Committee members are "exploring fully" the possibility of using part of the \$4,900,000,000 in reserve funds piled up by the Marshall Plan countries. Senator McCarran (D-Nev.) told reporters he saw no reason why these funds could not be used to strengthen the military defenses of Western Europe. Both McCarran and Knowland are members of the appropriations group.

Antihistamine Makers Agree To Soft-Pedal Claims

WASHINGTON —(P)—The government announced Friday that five big makers of anti-cold drugs have agreed to stop using allegedly "false and misleading" advertising to promote the sale of their products. The Federal Trade Commission said the action results from FTC complaints charging the firms with violation of federal fair trade laws. The five are Bristol-Myers Company, Anahist Company, Inc., and Whitehall Pharmaceutical Company, all of New York; Union Pharmaceutical, Inc., Montclair, N. J., and the Grove Laboratories, Inc., St. Louis, Mo. FTC's announcement said the companies have agreed to "discontinue representations concerning the effectiveness of their antihistamine preparations in the treatment of common colds." The products involved are sold under the trade names of Resistab, Anahist, Kriptin, Inhiston and Antamine. The government agency charged the antihistamine preparations would not cure colds as claimed by the makers.

Hood County dropped by 1,421 from 6,674 to 5,253, and Somervell County lost 539, from 3,071 to 2,532. New Braunfels almost doubled, jumping from 6,967 to 12,193, a gain of 5,217. Weatherford, Parker County seat, gained 2,129, from 5,924 to 8,053. Hockley County gained 7,727 from 12,693 to 20,420 but Stonewall County dropped 1,921 from 5,589 to 3,668. 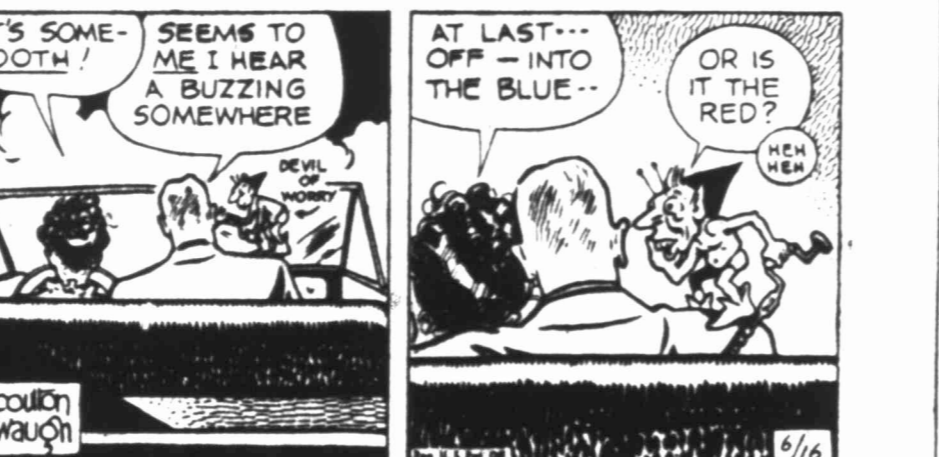

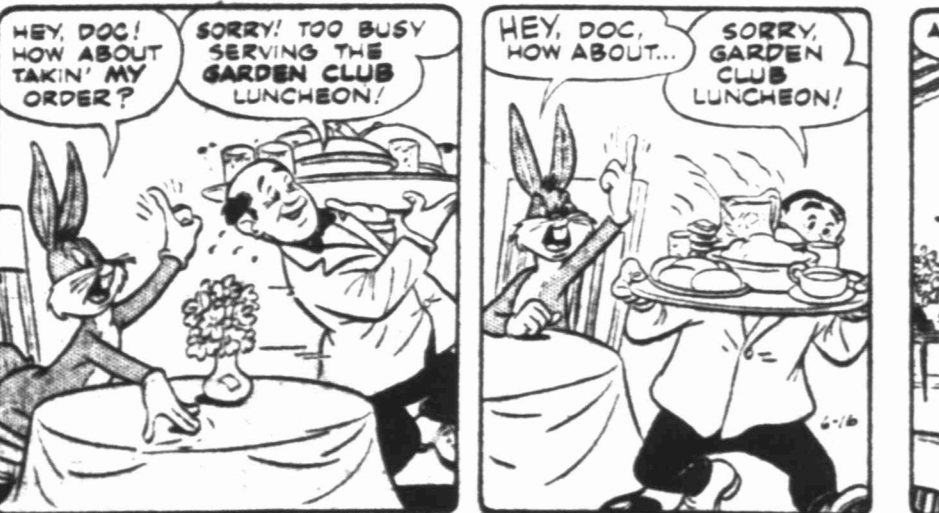

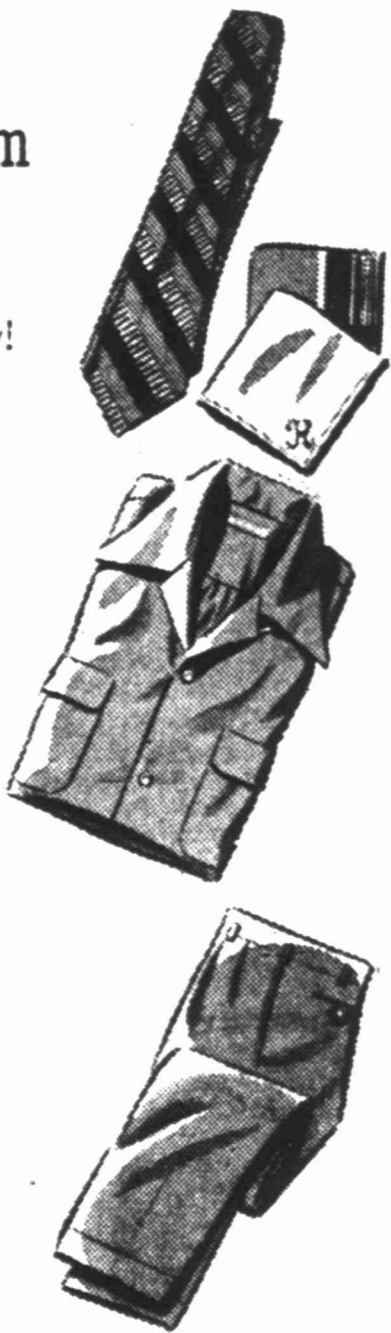

Slack said he never had been a Communist. The company's treasurer, Philip A. Suskind, described Slack as "very capable, never a trouble-maker" and a church-goer.

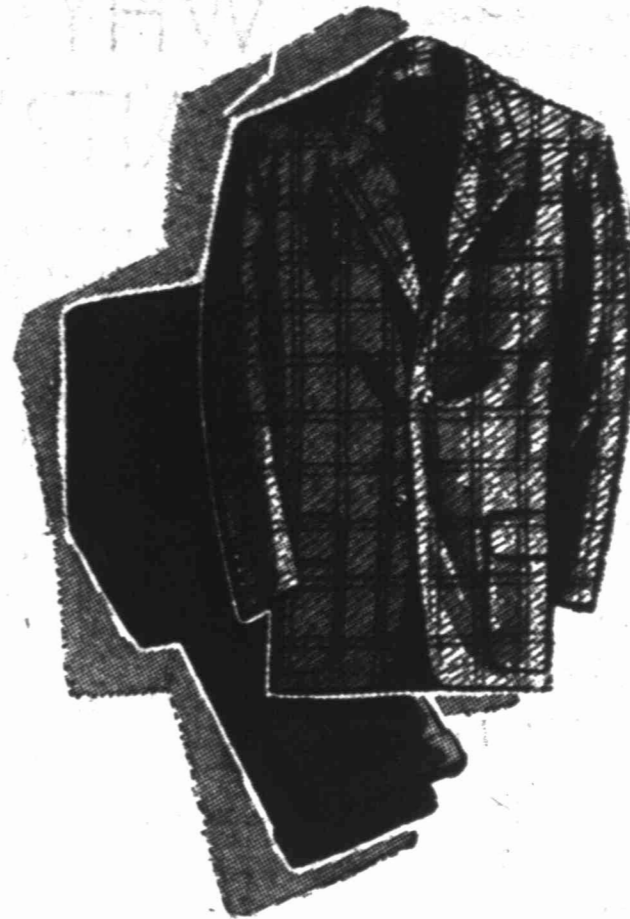
Former neighbors of the Slacks in Tennessee recalled the couple as "old."
