# Defense Rift Hampers Trial

MIAMI, Fla. (AP) — Defense counsel is in open disagreement over the kind of jurors they want to decide the fate of Candace Mossler and Melvin Powers, who are charged with murdering her husband.

Two Houston lawyers, Clyde Woody for Mrs. Mossler and Percy Foreman for Powers, asked a recess in which Foreman said they would try to "reconcile our differences" Tuesday.

After a closed conference, Foreman was asked if there had been any progress toward a meeting of minds on a joint defense strategy.

"No," he said. "How could there be?"

**NO EXPLANATION**  
He did not elaborate.

Foreman had told the court earlier that he and Woody disagreed on every one of the prospective jurors.

Mrs. Mossler, who says she is 39, and Powers, 29, are being tried on a charge that they murdered Jacques Mossler, 69, who willed his blonde wife millions of dollars in banking interests. Mossler was stabbed 39 times at a Miami apartment in 1964.

Despite the joint indictment, Foreman and Woody have indicated in quizzing jury candidates that they are pursuing separate courses in defense of their clients. Both had asked for separate trials.

State Atty. Richard Gerstein also has asked prospective jurors to consider the two cases individually. Gerstein said if one defendant was not placed at the scene of the crime by evidence, he could be convicted if he "aided, abetted, counseled, hired or procured" the killing.

**JURY PROSPECTS**  
Eighty-nine jury prospects had been called up by the end of Tuesday's session. Thirty-six

were dropped because of objection to the death penalty and 22 were dismissed for other causes allowed by Florida law. Nineteen have been challenged and 12 remain in the box.

Women appeared in the box for the first time Tuesday. Four were called up, but three were soon challenged by the defense.

Before the trial, Woody contended that the Florida system requiring women to register for duty was unconstitutional because it tended to exclude them from juries.

# Mexico Says Trade Climbs

MEXICO CITY (AP)—Mexico continued during 1965 its stepped-up economic development, says Minister of Industry and Trade Octaviano Campos Salas.

Talking with the press after his weekly audience with President Gustavo Diaz Ordaz, the minister said he had just informed the chief executive that Mexican exports jumped 8.6 percent during 1965 in comparison with those of 1964.

He said imports were also increased in 4.5 percent, mainly represented by raw materials, spare parts, machinery and other pieces of equipment directly used in bettering Mexico's production facilities.

Campos Salas reported "most satisfying results" in the fields of industrial production, where electrolytic copper, aluminum and steel ingots had increases of 33, 24 and 5 percent respectively.

# Cattle Industry Seen Approaching Crossroads

KANSAS CITY (AP) — The cattle industry is approaching a crossroad where the question will be "not of how much beef will be raised, fed and sold, but rather who will raise it, who will feed and sell it and how."

Orville Freeman, secretary of agriculture, made the statement Tuesday in a speech to the American National Cattlemen's Association.

Pressure is on for a better beef animal marketed in a more orderly manner, he said. The ancient pattern of buyer and seller getting together, looking

over the animal and haggling over price, apparently just won't do much longer.

"The future belongs to producers who can tailor their products to the needs of the market," Freeman said.

"Another important factor is the need for more accurate scheduling of deliveries. Cattlemen who can provide quantities of similar quality animals on a regular schedule will have the advantage."

He said government is bringing stability to the beef industry through its feed grain program.

# This Ticking Bag Harmless

SAN ANGELO, Tex. (AP) — Prepared for the worst, Trans-Texas Airlines officials and

San Angelo officers carted a ticking suitcase far from the airlines terminal at Mathis Field Tuesday.

The suitcase arrived on an afternoon flight and no one claimed it. When the ominous ticking was noted by Joe Caudle, station manager, he summoned officers.

"We don't take chances on anything," Caudle said.

# Crash Kills AF Major

DENISON, Tex. (AP) — Maj. Robert P. Ferguson, an Air Defense Command pilot from Colorado Springs, Colo., was killed Tuesday when an F102 jet

crashed after taking off from Perrin Air Force Base.

Ferguson's body was found under a tree about 300 yards from the burned wreckage. The plane crashed five miles north of Soper, Okla., across the Red River from Perrin. The Air Force base is located between Denison and Sherman, Tex. Officials said Ferguson was on an evaluation flight.

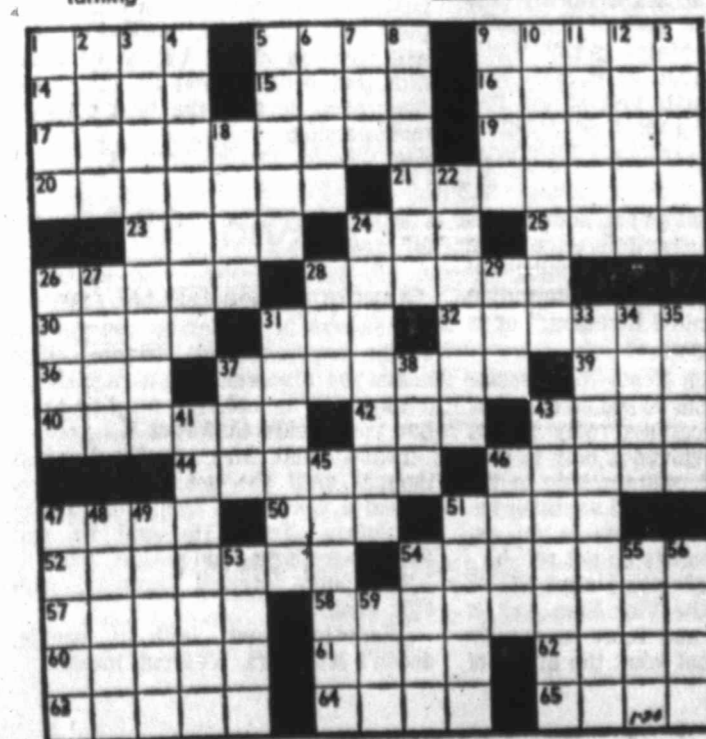
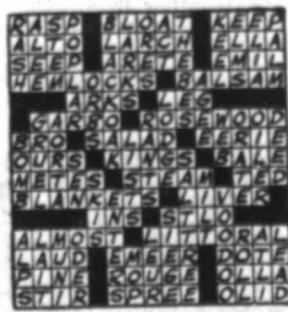

# Senators Divided On Bombing Issue

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Senate is widely divided on the issue of whether President Johnson should order a resumption of the bombing of North Viet Nam targets in the absence of any Communist peace feelers.

Of 50 senators willing to take a position in an Associated Press survey, 25 said they are against renewing air strikes at this point. Twenty-five said they favor resumption of bombing.

West opened the ace of hearts; however, despite the vigorous encouragement signaled by his partner, he was unable to continue the suit and shifted to a club. Declarer won the trick with the king of trumps and cashed the ace of trumps, on which East showed out, discarding a heart.

A club was led to the ace and the three of spades was returned. South played the four from his hand, permitting West to win a very cheap trick with the seven of spades.

West could not lead a club without giving the declarer a ruff and discard, so he cashed the ace of diamonds and continued the suit. South played the king of diamonds and led over to the queen. When the suit divided evenly, he was able to discard his last heart on North's nine of diamonds. His losses consisted of one spade, one heart, and one diamond.

If West exits with a club when he is in with the seven of spades, South can ruff in dummy and discard a diamond from his hand. A diamond is led to the king and West plays the ace. Declarer puts up North's queen of diamonds on the return and then ruffs a diamond to establish dummy's nine for the necessary heart sluff.

## Militarists May Leave Dominican

SANTO DOMINGO, Dominican Republic (AP) — If the Dominican Republic's top military men go abroad, their departure is not expected to lessen the army's opposition to ex-President Juan Bosch and his Dominican Revolutionary party.

In a move to lessen tensions, provisional President Hector Garcia-Godoy ordered top armed forces and rebel officers to diplomatic posts abroad Jan. 6.

## Rights Bill To Get Signature

FRANKFORT, Ky. (AP) — Gov. Edward T. Breathitt, adding a touch of drama to Kentucky's new civil rights bill, will sign it Thursday morning at the base of Abraham Lincoln's statue in the Capitol rotunda.

He hailed the unprecedented action of the General Assembly as "another step in Kentucky's steady civil rights progress over the past 15 years."

The state has become the first south of the Mason-Dixon Line to enact a comprehensive measure barring racial discrimination in public accommodations and jobs. The law takes effect July 1.

## Bank Head Loses Post

BLANKET, Tex. (AP)—Merrill Hill of Blanket was removed Tuesday as chairman of the board and president of the First State Bank of Bangs.

Hill also is president of the Blanket State Bank which was taken over for liquidation by the State Banking Department after the bank closed Tuesday to await an examination by a federal examiner.

The bank was reported by directors as being "in a falling condition." Blanket is a town of 600 population, located 11 miles northeast of Brownwood. Bangs is eight miles west of Brownwood.

## Rail Zephyr In Final Run

DALLAS (AP)—"It must have been like this, watching the stagecoaches go out of service," commented a passenger Tuesday as the San Houston Zephyr—one of the most celebrated trains in the Southwest—prepared to leave Dallas for Houston for the next to the last time.

The Burlington Lines train will start its last run to Houston at 5:15 p.m. today. Like many other historic passenger trains, it is vanishing because railroad officials claim passenger service is a losing proposition.

## Television's Wrangle With CATV Grows

WASHINGTON (AP) — The hue and cry over television's rich new competitor, Community Antenna Television, is building up again.

As before, television wants the 16-year-old CATV industry regulated by the Federal Communications Commission.

And now that the FCC seems about to take some step in that direction, the burgeoning CATV industry is angry and demanding congressional help.

That help does not, at this stage, seem forthcoming.

**BIG BUSINESS**  
Since 1950, people have been making a lot of money by erecting big television antennas near a community, plucking the signals of nearby and distant television stations from the air and relaying them by cable into the homes of subscribers who pay an average monthly fee of \$4.50.

## Campus-Park Plan Given Approval

City commissioners approved last night the contract between the city and the school board on the Lakeview School Park Campus project.

The vote ended several weeks of negotiation between the two groups on contractual technicalities. The issue had been settled at a joint meeting of the commission and school board last week; the acceptance of the contract was a formality.

Commissioners also okayed a proposal that the city pay for its share of the fencing around the park - campus, but that the schools will advertise for bids on fence construction.

Accepted "with regret" was the resignation of W. D. Broughton from the park and recreation board. Commissioners requested from Larry Crow, city manager, a list of prospective replacements for Broughton, which commissioners will look over in two weeks.

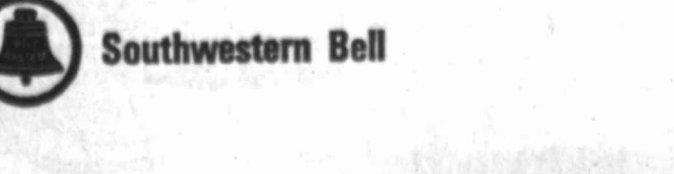
