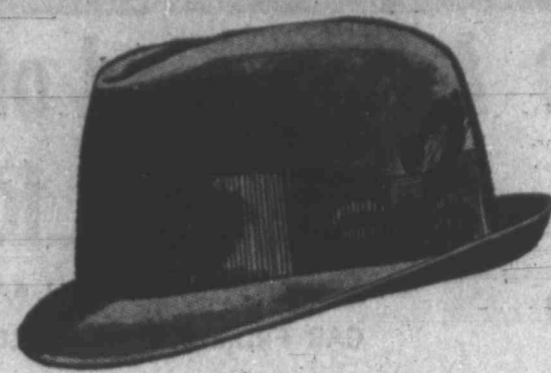

King-Sized Melon Theft Charged In Glasscock

GARDEN CITY — Pete Pantoza, San Angelo, was indicted Tuesday by the Glasscock County grand jury on a charge of felony theft.

Pantoza is accused of stealing 17,000 pounds of watermelons. The state alleges that Pantoza took 5,000 pounds of melons from Doris Blissard, Glasscock County commissioner, on one occasion and 12,000 pounds on a second occasion.

Wayne Burns, district attorney, said that Pantoza was the only defendant whose case was laid before the grand jury on Tuesday. Pantoza is at liberty on bond.

Burns said that the alleged theft was largely by false pretense—that Pantoza loaded the melons on Blissard's St. Lawrence farm and hauled them to Garden City to be weighed. Instead of leaving the melons at

the weighing station as he had promised, it is charged that he left with the loads and disposed of them.

Marriage Boom Still On Here

The strange boom in marriage licenses which has marked June, July and August is still in evidence, according to Mrs. Pauline Petty, Howard County clerk.

The office issued 12 licenses the first six days of September which matched the number for the first six days of August. There were 13 licenses issued the first six days of July and 14 in June—traditional month of weddings.

Mrs. Petty said that the steady demand for marriage licenses continues.

Nelson's Head Back In Dublin

DUBLIN, Ireland (AP) — Lord Nelson's 220-pound granite head — smuggled out of Ireland after the Nelson monument in the heart of Dublin was blown up by Irish extremists last March — is back in Dublin.

London antique dealer Benny Gray delivered the head to a Dublin official at a ceremony Tuesday at the spot where the 134-foot monument once stood.

Encephalitis Claims Another

CORPUS CHRISTI, Tex. (AP) — What is feared to have been the third death from St. Louis encephalitis in Corpus Christi occurred Tuesday.

Dr. W. R. Metzger, city-county health director, did not name the person but said the victim

was one of those on the list of patients suspected of being infected.

If it is confirmed, it will mean there have been 12 encephalitis deaths in Texas.

Dallas had seven deaths with 110 cases. Over the Labor Day weekend six suspected new cases developed.

Amarillo and Tulsa each had one encephalitis death.
