

# Texas Counts Violent Deaths

Texas counted 31 violent deaths during the weekend, including 24 in traffic accidents. The toll was recorded between 6 p.m. Friday and midnight Sunday.

Two of the victims remained unidentified at a late hour. One was a woman whose body was found Saturday in Austin's Town Lake, where she apparently went for a swim. The other was a man found Sunday after he presumably fell off an overpass in Southeast Houston.

**SMACKS POLE**  
These also, were among the dead:

Kenneth Rose, about 35, of Portland, Tex., stepped into a deep hole and drowned Sunday while fishing in Corpus Christi Bay.

Firemen found Louis W. Swindall, 64, suffocated in a bathroom after putting out a two-alarm fire in a Northeast Houston apartment.

Frank H. Williams, 26, was

shot and killed in a lounge near downtown Fort Worth early Sunday. Police held a woman.

Margaret Wilkins, 20, died in an Abilene hospital Sunday of injuries suffered as two cars collided Saturday on U.S. 67 in Brownwood.

Danny W. Brummerhop, 18, of Seabrook died Sunday in a Galveston hospital of injuries he received Saturday night when his car left Farm Road 518 near Kemah and struck a culvert.

David Robert Belkin, 19, of Mesquite was killed Sunday when his car skidded into a telephone pole in East Dallas County.

**BULLET WOUNDS**  
George Munez, about 25, was killed when the car in which he was riding struck a parked car in Dallas. Munez was thrown from his vehicle and was then run over by another vehicle which did not stop.

Tony Sorole, 21, of Houston, died Sunday of bullet wounds he received Saturday while sitting in his car. Companions told police a carload of youths pulled alongside their car and began firing. Two 16-year-old youths in the car were also wounded.

Robert Owens Jr., 39, of Houston, was killed early Sunday when the truck in which he was riding spun out of control and hit a guard rail on U.S. 59 near Houston.

Belinda Ales, 19, of Houston, was shot to death in a Houston apartment Sunday. Police held a man.
