> DALLAS (AP) - Black students took over the office of the president of Southern Methodist University today.

Vow To Stay

Reports from the scene said that 30 to 35 persons, believed all Negroes, said they would remain in the office until their demands are met.

Dr. Willis M. Tate, the president, left his office in the hands of the militants.

The takeover occurred during a meeting of Tate and a campus organization, the Black League of Afro-American and African College Students

Alarms Keep Police Busy

Fires, false alarms, vandalism and rock throwing kept police and firemen busy through the night in a continuation of racial troubles touched off by a strike of Negro hospital workers.

About 30 persons were arrested for violating a 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. curfew imposed by Gov. Robert McNair in the hope of

cooling the tension. Fire Chief Wilmot E. Guthke said two serious fires during the night were deliberately set. He said one in a storage shed was touched off by a fire bomb, and the other, in a supermarket by kerosene poured on the steps! Meanwhile the Rev. Ralph. David Abernathy placed a/halfpage advertisement in this morning's Charleston News and Courier to disclaim that the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, which he heads, is responsible for the violence.

Blanton Faces Life Sentence

TEXARKANA Ark (AP)-A jury convicted Kenneth Ray Blanton, 27, of Dallas Thursday of first degree murder and recommended a life sentence. Blanton was charged in the slaying of Winn Smith, 36, a prominent Texarkana businessman, whose body was found Dec. 15 in his apartment. Smith had been beaten and stabbed 17 times.

If no candidate gets a majority on the first round, the two top men will compete in a runoff election. June 15.

Georges Pompidou of the Gaullists is the only announced candidate so far and the favorite to replace the general he served for six years as premier. At least three men are competing for the Socialist nomination, a Communist candidate is likely, and there probably will be other entries

also All candidates must submit their petitions by midnight May 13. The campaign officially opens May 17.

Egypt, Israel Swap New Claims, Denials

Egypt and Israel have swapped news claims and denials but both have told Secretary-General U Thant they are 000 a year for a psychiatric con-, trying to limit danger to U.N. observers along the Suez Canal. * President Gamal Abdel Nas ser told a May Day rally in Cairo Thursday that Egyptian forces had destroyed 60 per cent of Israel's fortifications along

the east band of the waterway. Nasser also branded as a failure an Israeli raid Tuesday night on targets about 300 miles south of Cairo. He said warplanes, not commandos as the Israelis said, attempted the attack. He claimed the planes. were turned back before they could do any significant dam-

said Nasser, demon-This, strated the improvement - in Egypt's defense since last Oct. when Israeli commandos 31. damaged bridges, dams and a power plant in the same area.

Nasser said Egyptian shelling across the canal would continue until all the Israeli bases are destroyed. He hinted Egypt might launch a major attempt to retake the Sinai Desert, saying: "Who could blame us for movg into this land?"

Once more Nasser declared that the Arabs "will never give up any land occupied by Israel and particularly not Jerusa lem

"We will not accept that Jerusalem be annexed to Israel," he said. "We will fight to the last drop of our blood for the liberation of Jerusalem.

The Israelis countered Nasser's claims about the raid Tuesday night, saying an area Egyptian officials showed foreign newsmen was not the target of their attack. An army spokesman in Tel Aviv said the Israeli commandos brought down six power-line towers and the power grid's automatic control center in attacks near Isna

and Naj Hamadi 300 miles south of Cairo. Earlier, the Israelis 'said their men damaged the Naj Hamadi Dam and the Idfu bridge.

At U.N. headquarters a spokesman said Secretary-General Thant would issue a report to the Security Council today o Saturday on his "increasing anxiety for the safety" of the 92 military observers along the

Suez Canal cease-fire line. In letters to Egypt and Israel, Thant said unmistakably marked U.N. observation posts had "been repeatedly fired on by both sides" and U.N. property destroyed and damaged.

The Israelis replied they were "doing their utmost to reduce to the absolute minimum any risks to the observers." Egypt told Thant it would "cooperate completely with the U.N. observers to limit the dangers to which they are exposed." But each side blamed the other for the situation

The organization had presented a petition earlier containing 13 pages of demands.

Tate issued his reply today after widespread faculty, consultation.

The administration refused one of the key demands of the black group-that SMU recruit 500 Negro students for entrance next September. The school now has about 50 black students of about 6,000 students and most of them in graduate school.

A formal statement from the university issued today said, "SMU, as a private-university, must maintain the right to set its own standards for admission and to select its faculty on the basis of specific goals for SMU." But the administration statement said the school would hire

two Negroes to help black students seek admissio The administration also turned

down any specific ratio of black and white instructors, although it said it would seek qualified Negro teachers.

Tate said in the formal statement, "No person or group will be allowed to disrupt the university's normal functioning or resort to violence or destruction. If disruption of normal functioning is engaged in by any person or group, they will be subject to severe discipline."

Before the office takeover. Tate commended what he called the "rational conduct of a majority of the league's representatives."

The president agreed to em-ploy two black students this summer as admission, counselors in an effort to recruit "more qualified black students."

To meet other requests in the petition, the president said the school will revise some courses to make them more relevant to the black community, will institute a goal of employing more black instructors, create a human relations board of both races, and establish a house for social and business affairs of black students provided it will be open to all attending the school

It also means that the center of our affections is in those things that pertain to the spiritual lifewitnessing for Christ, learning more about the Bible, understanding more and more about the meaning and privilege of prayer. It should also mean that our lives revolve around Christ and His Church. It also means that we do not enjoy those ways of the world which are unclean, unwholesome and base and which leave a stain on one's mind and heart and character.

Another definition of the spiritually minded is a person who keeps a proper perspective between the things of this world, which will perish and the things of God, which will last for eternity. When we see ourselves and the things all around us in the light of God's eternity it helps us keep an even keel. The Bible tellsus: "The natural man, (the uncon-verted man), receiveth not the things of the spirit of God: For they are foolishness unto Him: Neither can he know them, because they are spiritually 'discerned." For that reason it is tremendously important that all of us become "spiritually minded."

Ray had been given a life-sentence, and the jury in Tennessee spared much mental anguish by agreement among the attorneys and instructions by the judge. It must have seemed monstrously unfair that jurors in Los Angeles had to do what their opposite numbers in Dallas and Memphis were excused from doing

THE SENTENCERS of Sirhan had to overcome the offered temptation of holding the killer mentally irresponsible.
