# CO And Family Travel In Europe

## County Tells

at 1:30 a. m. Saturday June 20 and arrived in Munich for breakfast. Before eating, we visited the big statue of Lady of Bavaria. One can climb the stairs and look out her eye, but we were too hungry for that. We saw the "Glockenspiel". It is little figures of barrel makers on a building in the center of town. It is a musical instrument of bells fastened to an iron rod and struck by a hammer to make tones. They dance every day at noon, but of course it was too early for us to see them dance. The story behind them is that after the Black Plague the people were still afraid to leave their homes. The barrelmakers finally went out into the street and started to play and dance. The people soon forgot being afraid and joined in the activities.

**A Crazy King's Castle**  
We ate breakfast in the snack bar at the Army Post there, and then went on to Garmisch. We got there about noon, so we pitched

a tent and fixed lunch. Garmisch is a year-round resort and it's lovely. There are high mountains in the back of the town. After lunch we went to Linderhof Castle, one of King Ludwig's castles. He was a crazy man but his castles are fabulous! Afterwards we stopped by Oberammergau where they have the Passion Plays every ten years. Next year it will be the year for it. We didn't get to go inside the playhouse because it had already closed for the day.

**To the Isle of Capri**  
Sunday morning we took a boat to the Isle of Capri, then boarded a streetcar up to the town. It went nearly straight up - craziest thing! Then we went by bus to the beach coming back to Naples in the afternoon. Around 10 Monday morning, we drove to Caserta and saw a palace there. The grounds and gardens were beautiful. The tour for going inside was over so we didn't see the inside of the building. From there we motored to Capua, cut across the coast road to Gaeta, Terracina, Velletri and into Rome where we camped.

**Through Brenner Pass**  
Next we came through Innsbruck, the capitol of Austria and a tourist resort, then on through Brenner Pass connecting Italy with Germany. Then we were in Italy where we went through Bressanone, Bolzano, and stopped at Trento, where we camped. We left Monday morning at 9:30 for Verona where there is an Army Base where we bought our Italian gas coupons and ate lunch in the Snack Bar. We left there at 1:30 traveling to the base in Vicenza. From this point we went to Padova, Mestre, Noghera, Trepanade, Capo Sile, Jesolo, and camped at Lido where we went swimming.

Tuesday morning we took the boat to Venice, taking a gondola to see the town. We visited a glass factory as well as seeing Saint Mark's Cathedral. Also we ate spaghetti in Venice. That afternoon we took the boat back Wednesday morning we left at nine for Padova. On to Moselice, Rovigo, Ferrara, Ravenna and camped at Rimini, leaving Thurs-

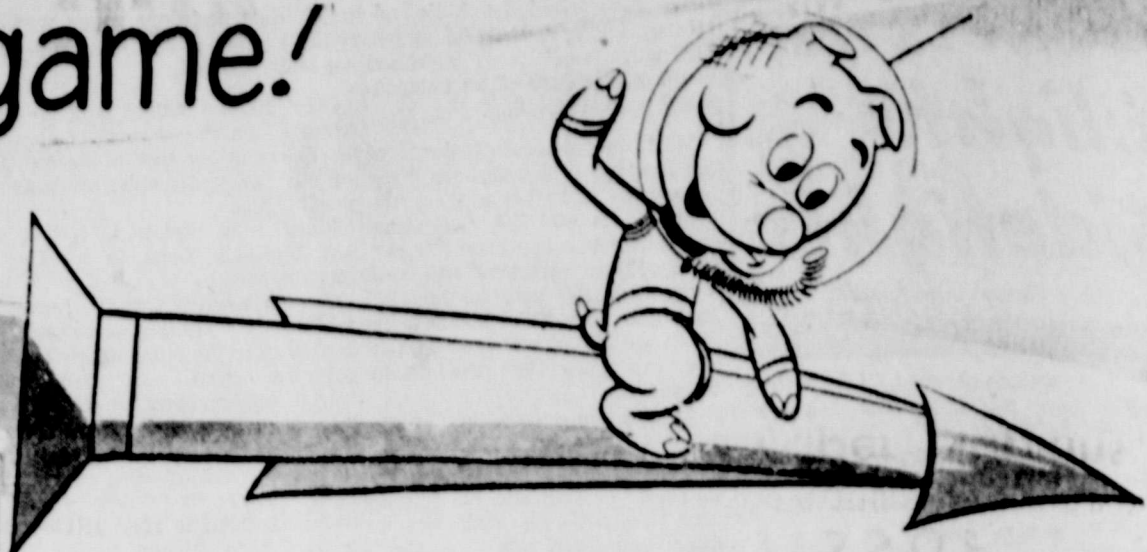
