 CONTAGION FORESEENFuture Generations to Be Immune From Germs.
Paris.- The day may be approach: ing when mankind can be immunized causes of death can be reduced to old age, the wearing out of organs or ac cidents.
Sclence already has means of preventing four of the gravest diseases which have caused serious ravage hundreds of sclentists are continuing their stndies to provide vaccines to their studies to provide vaccines the other ills to which we have been heir. The Pasteur institute, the Curie institute and the Academy of Medicine are all centering their efforts on finding vaccines, and at present the greatest attention is being pald the ant
tuberculosis vaceine of Calmetie tuberculosis vaceine of Calmette.

Smallpox Scare.
Already vaccination against smallpox, diphtherla, typhold, and parayphold fevers has proved successful, the tuberculosis vaceine, which is now being widely used in France, and it being wddely used in France, and
will be necessary to walt for the re sults of the next ten years before science can say definitely whether the Calmette vaccine is a preventive or a danger.
The recent smalipox scare in Europe which followed the transport of the sengers and crews on liners caused a sudden increase in vacelnations which almost taxed to its limit the production capacity of the Pasteur institute. Modern engineering has come to the aid of science, however, and by the ase of most modern American refrig. eration machinery and methods, it is now possible to make up serums in
vast quantities and store them away vast quantities and store them away that created by the British smalipes scare. World is Prepared.
Professor Lerchoulet of the French Academy of Medicine, one of the out standing authorities on vaccination in Europe, said that the world is today perfectly prepared to tight against epicould be forever contagious discase tons would adopt the if an ma proven weuld ado "Smallpox has
as an epidemic in France appeare there are rare scattered cases, espe cially in port towns." Professor Lereboulet said.
"Every year sees several hundred thousand persons vaccinated against smalipos in France, especially school
children, soldlers and people living cttles who are most subject to contagion. Our vaccination work has been so successful and the public has accepted it so heartlly that today it Is safe to say France has no fears of
smallpox. smallpox.
"Similar campaigns to encourage vaccination against diphtheria have had goon results. A haif millong chitease annually with the result that is has atmost disappeared in our hogpt tals. We will continue untll the entire French youti, atiout $8,000,000$ children, is immune.
"The anti-typhold vaccine has now meen proven successful, and already
hundreds of thousands of persons rotuntarily seek Immunization annuall. The Calmette vacine against tubercutosis can be said to be still in in stage of observation, but we have seen onty good results so far and 200.000 children are vaccinated manually
