"Our highway traffic has become so unsafe," the pastor said, "that the moment a person drives upon the public thoroughfare, if he has any regard for his future abode, he should sing softly and seriously as the speedometer climbs upward the following hymns:

"At 25 miles per hour, 'I'm but a stranger Here. Heaven is My Home;' at 45 miles, 'Nearer My God, to Thee;' at 55 miles, 'I'm Nearing the Port and Will Soon be at Home;' at 65 miles, 'When the Roll is Called up Yonder I'll be There;' at 75 miles, 'Lord I'm Coming Home.'"
