to Washington as Congresman Johnson's assistant.

In 1956 Lyndon Johnson tapped Connally to place Johnson's name in nation for President at the Democratic National Convention.

nomination for him. Later, Connally was active in Johnson's Texas campaign As a reward, Connally was tagged for the post of Secretary of the Navy shortly after President Kennedy visited Vice-President-elect Johnson's ranch
The New York Times termed Connally's appointment as "Mr. Johnoon's bigges patronage plum." (June 4, 1962) years, resigned to run for Governor of Texas. Time magazine said Connally announcement for Governor "certainly seemed to carry Lyndon Johnson" political fingerprints." (December 22, 1961) After Connally's victory over
Yarborough, Time said "His mentor Lyndon Johnson thus tightened his grip on the Texas Democratic organization." (June 8, 1962) All over Texas long-time Lyndon Johnson backers are spearheading Connally's million dollar campaign. Why? Federal pay offs from the Kennedy-
