| Upton County voters gave sub stantial approval to the $\$ 300,000$ hospital proposals at the polls last Saturday, with 327 votes cast for the proposition and 211 against. <br> Only one box voted against the proposal, that being box 1 in Rankin which voted 47 against and 44 for. 44 for. <br> A heavier turnout of voters was made than was expected by most advance guesses" of ebservers. Most ex be cast. <br> Only property taxpayers could vote in the election. <br> The returns from the election were canvassed and approved by the Upton County Commissioners Court Monday, and the body set Court Monday, and the body set Monday, March 24, as the day they would name an architect for the Rankin hospital to be built under the election proposition.
