# ODESSA MAN KILLS SELF NEAR PLYMOUTH CAMP IN BENEOUM 

| Floyd Lawrence Hall, 42, com mitted suicide about 12 miles south east of Rankin last Sunday after noon, Justice of the Peace Omar Warren ruled Tuesday. <br> Hall was found about 200 yards off the Benedum road, about a half mile west of the Plymouth Gasoline Plant, by an oilfield worker. He and shot himself in the right temple, Sheriff H. E. "Gene" Eckols said. The fatal shot was fired from a 22 rifle. <br> Hall had lived in Odessa until January of this year, and faced charges there of attempting to kill | his brother filed that month. was free under $\$ 1,000$ bond. <br> More recently, he had operated a cafe at Lake Walk, near Del Rio, until April 15. No further trace of his whereabout could be determined prior to the finding his lifeless body last Sunday. <br> No note was found. <br> Upton County officers were still seeking to locate his mother and brother late Wednesday night, believed to be somewhere in Oklahoma. <br> The body is at the Spalding Funeral Home in McCamey, with arrangements pending. |
