At a recent Monday luncheon meeting, district attorney Connell Ashley explained to the group that the law as now written says that a new county may be created by a two thirds affirmative vote by the legislature. When a part of one county is merely transferred to another county, it must receive a two thirds approval from the legis. lature and affirmative votes by the people of the counties affected. The Jaycee proposal would make necessary for the county or coun. ties to approve the creation of a new county from a part of their territory.
The Pioneer stated that "The prbposal was aimed at an Iraan group that agitated for the forma.
tion of a county to be known as Permian earlier this year."
The Pioneer also mentioned that Ashley and county attorney Shelby Blaydes have asked for an opinion on the meaning of the law from state attorney general Will Wilson.
