# Safety Tips Offered By Utilities Co. Manager

Local children were cautioned today against flying kites near electric wires by Fred Welling, local manager for West Texas Utilities Company.

He suggested an open field, away from electric wires and busy streets as an ideal place for kiteflying. "It is dangerous to fly kites in the streets or anywhere near poles and wires, partly because of traffice hazards and partly because kites may come in contact with electric lines," the WTU manager said.

"If a kite gets caught in electric wires, a child may receive an electrical shock, or at best may lose his kite," Welling warned. He emphasized, however, that kiteflying can be completely safe if a few simple rules are followed.

The WTU manager made his plea for safety as warm temperatures and steady breezes signalled the beginning of the spring kiteflying season.

"If a kite does become caught in the wires, don't try to get it down. Either leave it alone, or call the WTU office for assistance," he suggested.

In discussing electrical safety, the power company spokesman also urged parents to use care when they are moving outside television or radio antennas without expert help. He pointed out that WTU servicemen would be glad to advise them concerning high voltage lines near their homes.

DOES "WELFARE" MAKE CHIME?-

By John T. Flynn Written for "Texas Tax Journal"

Is there any connection between welfare and crime? A lot of people are asking that question in one form or another. But nobody can give a definite answer because nobody has made an objective study of the subject.

Sometimes the question is asked differently-for example: What effect does welfare have on the character of the American people? Here again, a definite answer can not be given. But perhaps we can get an inkling from certain revealing facts, of what the answer

The "welfare' 'referred to, of course, means outright government handouts to individual citizens. These handouts may seem to come from generous and benevolent governments, federal, state, and local-but in reality they come from self-reliant and energetic Americans who work hard for salaries, wages, etc. The government then step in, tax the results of their labor and use part of these taxes to make the handouts.

Now the last 20 years in these United State: have been years of boom and prosperity. They have been, of course, periods of recession, but generally speaking anybody who really wanted a job could get one. But evidentally there is a growing segment of our population who would rather live off the earnings of others. That may seem like a harsh and coldhearted statement. But the Tax Foundation recently made a study of welfare payments in he United States which reveals some shocking figures. We must keep in mind two things about these fig-

The first is that they refer to a period of great prosperity.

The second is they include only outright handouts-what we used to call doles. They do not include as fast as the population. social security payments or pay- It would be of great value if

name of "public assistance"which means, as we said, plain

Well, in the last 20 years-years of raging prosperity-this outright welfare spending by the federal government has risen 685 percent! In the case of state and local

governments, it has risen 117 per-

These incredible figures mean that there are nearly SEVEN MILLION AMERICANS living on outright doles from the govern-

Undoubtedly, some of these people cannot help themselves. But how many of these people have fallen for the vicious notion that the government owes everybody a living? Why Work? Why not just sit back and let the government take care of you? This is what is meant when someone asks what effect welfare is having on the character of the American peop-

There was a time when the American was the most independent, self-reliant individual in the world. He considered it a major ingredient of his own moral integrity to earn his own way if he possibly could. What, then, are we to think when SEVEN MIL-LION AMERICANS-in a period when in many spots jobs were going begging-were willing to accept government handouts at the expense of their fellow working

As to whether all this has anything to do with crime, it would be interesting to know if there is any connection between these figures and a recent statement by J. Edgar Hoover of the FBI. Mr. Hoover made the startling revelation that crime in the United States is at an all-time high. He said that last year there were more than 1,500,000 serious offenses committed throughout the nation. And this cannot be blamed on the increase in our population because, as Mr. Hoover pointed out, crime has risen FOUR times





A constitutional amendment (H.J.R. #4) is being considered whereby Texans will be given an opportunity to legalize horse race betting in Dallas, Tarrant, Harris, Galveston, Bexar, Midland, Hidalgo, Cameron and Webb Counties, subject to approval by LOCAL OPTION.

H.J.R. #4 provides for distribution, ANNUALLY, among all counties that do not have race tracks, one-half of the STATE TAX REVENUE obtained from horse racing. Each county would receive approximately \$1.00 per capita population the first year. Counties where the tracks are located would receive 2% of parimutuel handle. The state's tax income from horse racing alone would run close to

\$12,000,000 the very first year—possibly more—besides all the income tourists would bring to Texas-which would amount to millions of dollars, plus a great ad valorem tax on race tracks, breeding farms and many valuable race horses.
