Planting Trees in Upton County

We have had inquiries in the past several months on how to plant trees and care after planting. In this article, some of the major points will be discussed.
The first thing to consider is the type of tree to be pianted. Pecan tiees in Upton County do well along with non-bearing mulberry. But regardless of the type of tree planted, there are some post-planting care that should be exercised.
This article will be discussed from the back-yard tree planting standpoint. We have a list of many varieties of fruit and pecan trees that have done well in Upton County. I am going to list only a few pecan and peach trees. If any other information is desired, contact my office.
Peach - Some of the better ones; Ranger, Hale Haven.
Pecan category - some $\alpha$ the new varieties for this part of the state; Wichita, Western Schley. Sioux. Comanche
Now is the time of year to plant trees and they can be planted through March. It is best of plant trees in January to give the root system time to become soll adapted before the top growth begins in the spring.
Always plant trees as deep or 3 inches deeper than they were planted in the nursery. Dig the holes large enough to accomodate the entire root system without bending or trimming back any

it is damaged by shipping or dig ging.
Try to plant trees as soon a
they are received from the nursery. For success in planting the trees, follow some simple rules.

Secure sound and bigger stock from a reputable nursery I prefer trees 5 to 7 ft in height. This type tree usually represents 4 year root stock and 2 year top growth.
2. Keep root spstem moist at all times before planting.
3. Dig hole large enough
comodate the root system
4. Set tree at same depth or beow, as it stood in nursery 5. Fill hole with water, and fill with top-soll dug from the hole This will firm the soll around the root system, and void the hole of air pockets.
Trees need very little fertiliza tion the first year. Beginning o the second year, use a nitrogenous fertilizer in split application The first one in late winter, the second in late May or June. In pecans particularly, Zinc Sulph te -2 lbs. in 100 gallons water It should be applied to the young ree when leaves are about one third grown
In high caicoreous soll such as we have in Upton County, one or two additional foiar sprays needed in approximately three-week ntervals.
Do not apply zinc Sulphate to peach or plum trees at $t$ his
trength.

al growth on bearing pecan tree is $7-15$ inches per year - tree making this amount of growth should receive only enough nitrogen to maintain this rate of growth. This is applied one-half th. of Ammonium Sulphate per dia-meter-inch of tree trunk, applied in the late winter around drip line of tree. Insect and disease control will be discussed in a later news article.

For old established pecan trees we have a bulletin entitled "Pecan Disease and Insects." It has regular spray schedules in it.
