## Financial Focus

This Mother's Day, Give a Gift That Lasts It's almost Mother's Day. This year, instead of giving
Mom flowers or candy-or at least in addition to the flowers or candy--why not give a gift that can last? Specifically, why
not help your mother--or your grandmother--improve her financial picture?
Of course, you could always just give a gift of cash, but there are many other ways to help out. You could, for
example, give stocks. It isn't much more difficult than giving cash, but you do have to keep a few things in mind. Make sure you know what you originally paid for the stock (its "tax
basis"), how long you've held it basis (I), how long you've held it and its fair market value at
the date of the gift. You'll also need to determine if you have to pay gift taxes. (You can give up to $\$ 11,000$ per year, free of gift taxes, to as many people as you want.) Your mother will need this information to determine gains or losses when
she decides to sell the stock you've given her she decides to selnd your mother can gain valuable tax
Both you and advantages from your gift of stock. When you gave your mother the stock, you also gave her your "holding period"--the
amount of time you've held the stock. So, even if she only owns the stock for a day or so before selling it, she'll just have to pay the long-term capital gains tax rate, which may be considerably lower than her current income tax rate. And by
giving your mother the shares of stock, you will also benefit-giving your mother the shares of stock, you wave to pay if you sold the stock yourself. However, before taking any action, consult with your tax adviser to discuss these issues. As an alternative to giving your mother shares of stock
outright, you might also consider contributing to her IRA. She can put in up to $\$ 3,000$ per year to a Traditional or Roth IRA-and, if she's 50 or over, she can add an extra $\$ 500$ in "catch-up" contributions.
