Athena Study Club

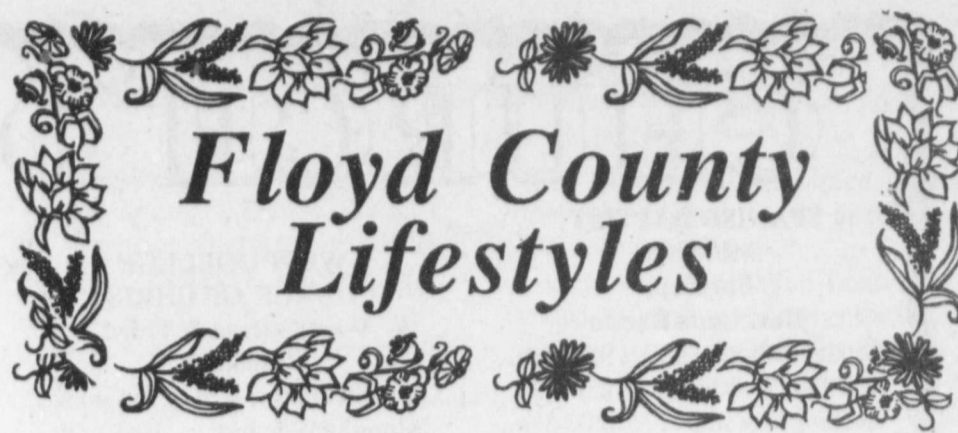
