**MAYFIELD'S LEAD OVER PEDDY, 114,340**

Earle B. Mayfield's Majority over George Peddy for United States Senator probably will be under 120,000. Totals given out by the Texas Election Bureau, Nov. 8th gave him a majority of 112,818, out of 284,614 votes counted. In 320,340 votes tabulated today he had a majority of 114,340, gaining only 1,522 in the 36,000 additional votes accounted for. Today's tabulation showed:

Returns from 149 counties are incomplete with 60 complete. Forty-two counties have not reported.

Of the reported counties, Peddy carried 27 and Atwell 6.
