## Vote For Bill Murray.

There are several reasons why Cisco area citizens should carefully consider the qualifications of W. J. (Bill) Murray when they cast their votes Saturday in the Railroad Commissioner's race.

Most important, perhaps, is the fact that Bill Murray has demonstrated very effectively that he knows his job, is entirely reliable and is genuinely interested in Texas and Texans. Education and experience especially qualify him for the position he seeks.

Another reason why we should all particularly want our oil conservation program in competent hands is the fact that the local oil picture is looking better each day. That Murray is interested primarily in Texas was recently demonstrated when he declined appointment as chief of the federal oil conservation forces in Washington. The fact that this place was offered him is evidence plenty that Bill Murray rates high in the oil fraternity.

Cisco remembers Bill Murray as an honor graduate of its high school. At the University of Texas, he won the honor of graduating with the highest grades ever given in the engineering department. After teaching at the University for a year, he joined the Railroad Commission's proration forces. He won additional honors for competent handling of the duties of petroleum administrator for District Three, including much of the southwest.

Gov. Beauford Jester appointed Murray to the Railroad Commission when he resigned in 1947 to become governor of the state. Murray now is asking election to fill out the unexpired term he is serving.

The good work that he has done in the office merits his election in Murray, Texans have a man who appears destined to go far in the field of public service.

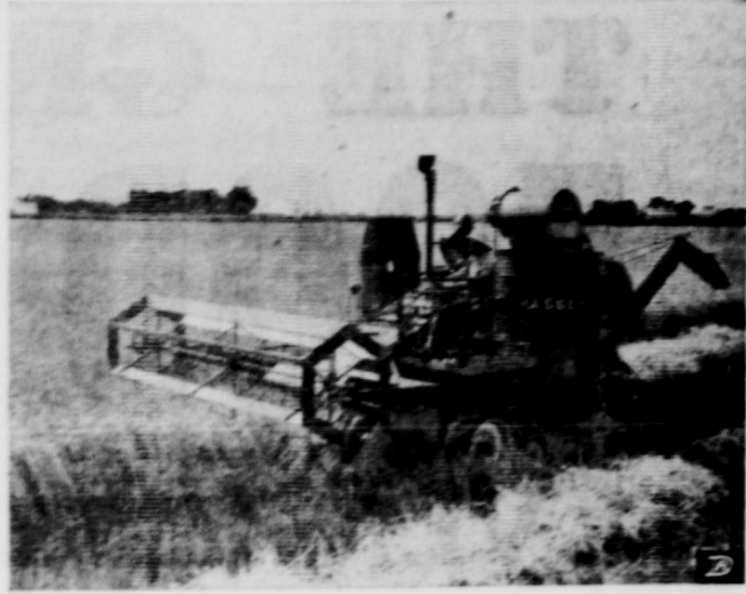
