The Abernathy score and margin may be the biggest district win by FHS. The 1998 Chieftains
had beaten Lubbock Roosevelt, $58-6$, a 52 -point margin, a couple of years after the 1996 Chieftains outscored Sanford-Fritch, 56-6.
A 1952 game didn't make the list, but for sheer numbers, it bears mention. The Chiefs beat Anton, 61-33 that season, and the 94 points may be a onegame record. We haven't found one higher.
