The world will little note, nor long remember what we
say here; while it can never say here; while it can never
forget what they did here. It is rather for us, the
living, we here be dedicated to the great task remaining
before us--that from these honore us dead we take
honcreased devotion to that cause increased devotion to that cause
for which they here, gave the
last full measure of devotion last full measure of devotion--
that we here highly resolve these dead shall not have died
in vain; that the nation shall have a new birth of freedom,
and that government of the and that government of the
people, by the people, for the
people, shall not perish from people, shall not perish from
this earth.

These few words, 238 of them, have lived through
history and taught to countless students.
No doubt President Abraham Lincoln made many
inspiring speeches during his lifetime. But none so
enduring as the Gettysburg enduring as the Gettysburg
Address, delivered on NovAddress, delivered on Nov-
ember 19, 1863 .
John Nicolay, one of John Nicolay, one of
Lincoln's two private Lincoln's two private
secretaries, said that Lincoln
wrote the first part of the wrote the first part, of the
speech on Executive Mansion speech on Executive Mansion
stationery, The second page
was written in pencil on lined The text above is taken
from Mr. Nicolay's copy and differs slightly from the
version that version that most school
children learn. Read it again, only this time out loud like you were delivering the
speech. Put some emotion into it. You'll feel more patriotic. you could even memorize it and impress yo
Sunday School.
Lord knows we need to
feel patriotic these days. Do you realize that in America oday, in the 21 st Century,
you can not go to an airport and get mad at security or airline employees.
I remember back during my airsine and travel agent counters or departure gates
would often throw wall-eyed would often throw wall-eyed
fits and raise holy hell if a
flight was late. (What is a wall-eyed fit anyway?)
I've seen passengers
threaten to climb over the threaten to climb over the
ticket counter and do bodily
harm to an airline employee harm to an airline employee
for a variety of reasons. for a variety of reasons.
But now? A wall-eyed fit at the airport could get you a
prison sentence. Do you prison sentence. Do you
realize that you can not get mad at airport security personnel? No matter what
they do to you, how you strip off your clothes, take off your shoes, your
choice in America today is to choice in America today
stand there and take it.
If you call one of them stupid, refuse to cooperate,
bad mouth or back talk, it bad mouth or back talk, it
will be handcuffs, interrogation, maybe even national forbid that you actually touch a security person in a
threatening way. Federal
prison here prison here I come.
Don't believe me? Buy ticket, go to an airport, and
throw a wall-eyed fit. We'll see you in a couple of years. do with Mr. Lincoln's
Gettysburg Address? Not much I guess. Except for that
last part there that says "that the nation shall have a

that government of the people, by the people, for the
