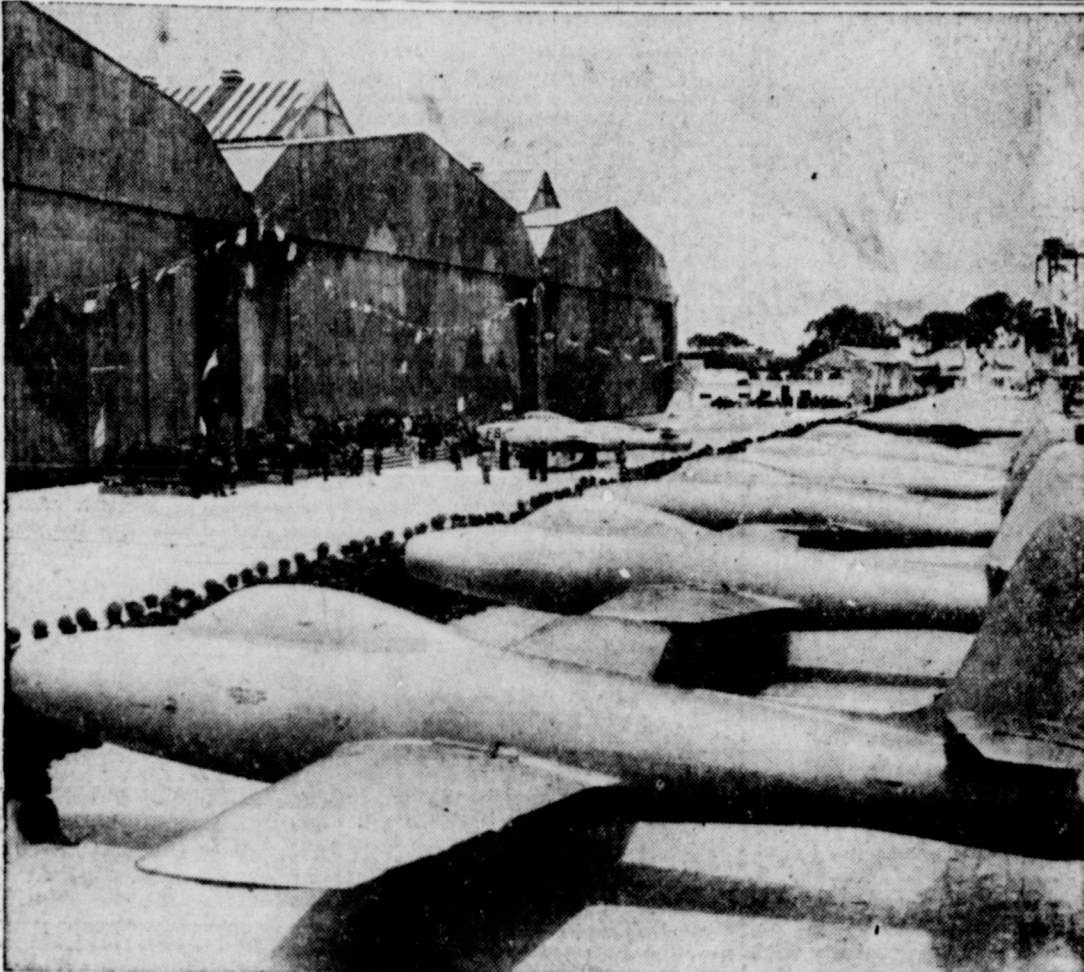

Aviation Cadets Being Recruited

Qualified men from this area may now make application for Aviation Cadet training in the U S Air Force at the US Army and US Air Force Recruiting Station in Eastland.

Those who meet the required qualifications will be sent at Government expense to Goodfellow Air Force Base, San Angelo for further processing prior to assignment to a training class.

General qualifications are: Age 19-26½; 60 semester hours of college; vision 20/20 for pilots, 20/50 for observers; height 64 to 74 inches; single; and never been "washed out" of flight training or officer candidate school.

While only those men with 2 years of college are eligible for appointment from civilian life, this road to silver wings and a commission in the USAF is also open to men with a high school diploma who can pass the required mental examination. These men must enlist in the US Air Force and then make formal application for training.

Interested individuals are urged to contact the Eastland Recruiting Station as soon as possible for full details on the program, which is the largest since WW II.

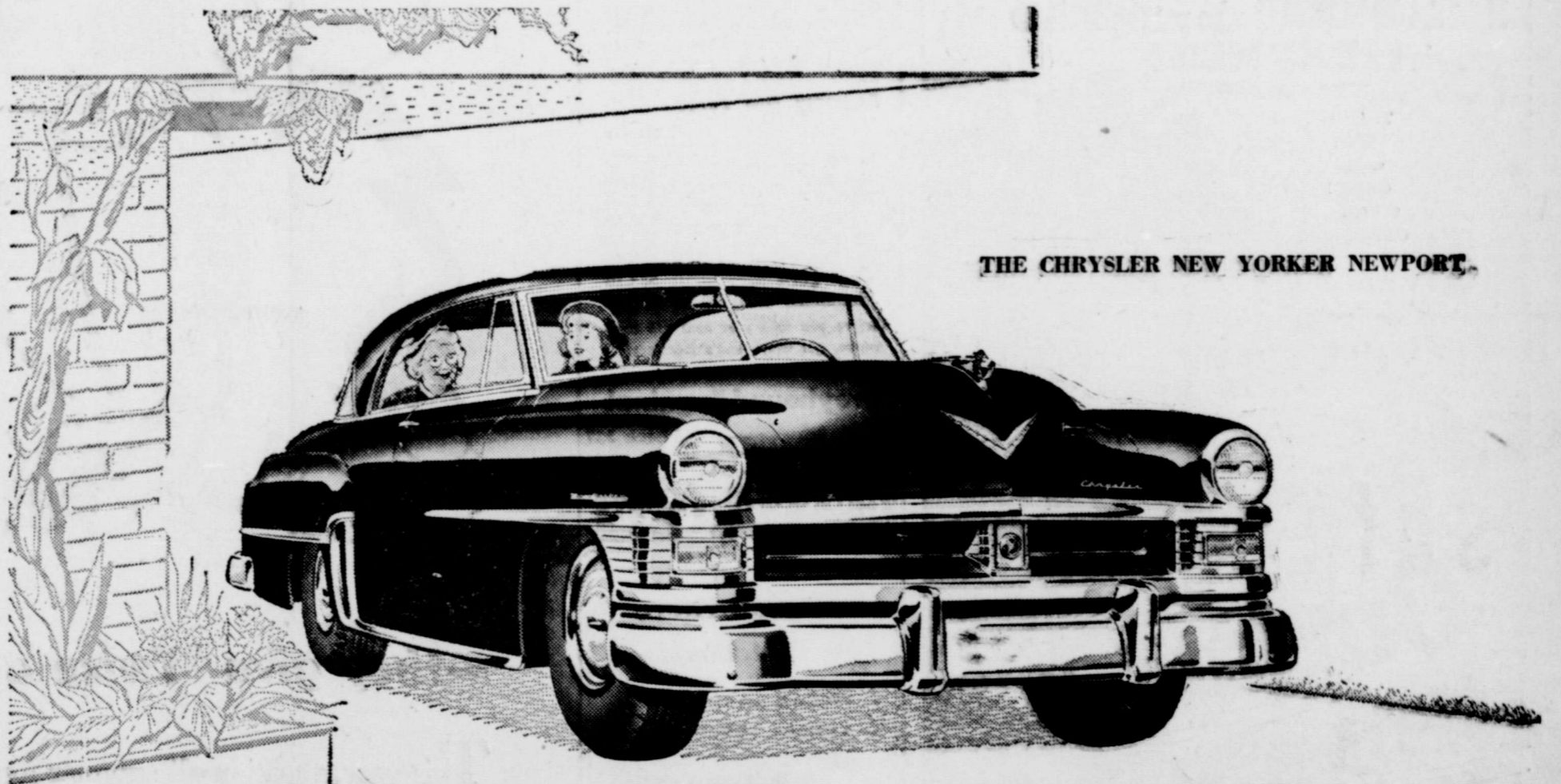

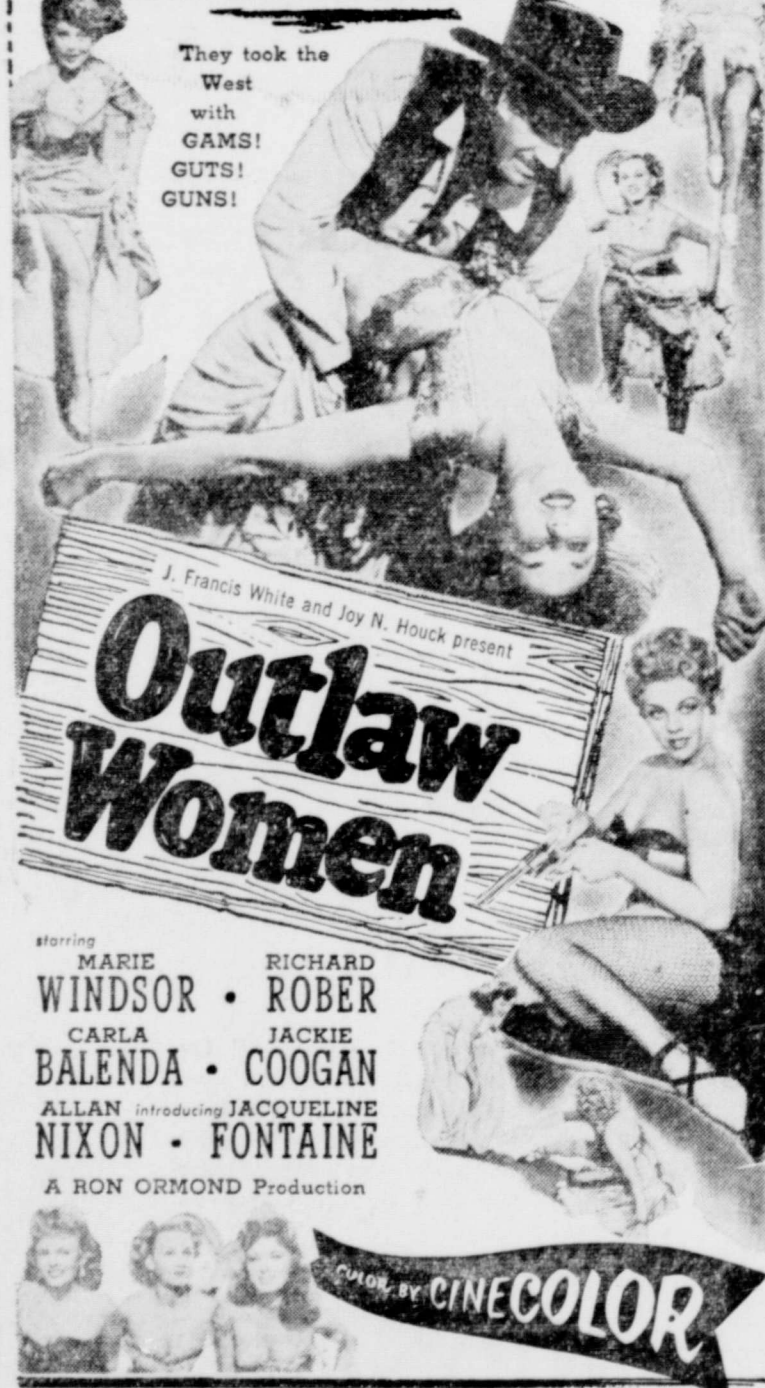

Work Stoppage Helps Fishing

BEAUMONT, May 24. — Recent industrial disruption, primarily in the oil industry, stimulated fishing activities mainly in the marine areas, according to Warden Supervisor Lewis Morris. He said the sale of commercial fishing licenses boomed just as soon as the big refineries and other plants closed temporarily. Morris explained that the workers by buying a \$3 commercial fishing license and \$1 tags for each stretch of netting could wade out into the shallow bays and make pretty good catches of fish, such as speckled trout, shrimp and crabs.

HEALTH TALKS

What's the spleen? Aye, there's the rub. Through all the ages, poets and sages have looked and studied human anatomy and come up with answers to most questions. But the spleen gets curiousest and curiousest.

Shakespeare had a fling at the spleen when he wrote in "A Midsummer Night's Dream." "Swift as a shadow, short as a dream;

Brief as the lightning in the collied night,

That in a spleen, unfolds both heaven and earth,

And ere a man hath power to say "Behold!"

The jaws of darkness to devour it up."

Perhaps one of the most important discoveries about the spleen is that you can live without it. It is located on the far left side of the body, under the ribs. It lies behind and to the left of the stomach, it touches the diaphragm which lies above it, it touches the left kidney which lies below it and it touches the pancreas which lies to the right.

The artery branch that feeds

blood to the spleen (splenic artery) is the largest of the abdominal arteries and the vein that takes blood from the spleen (splenic vein) is the largest branch of the abdominal veins.

So there is much traffic in and out of the spleen. As a go-between for the arteries and the veins it may be considered as the

body's big capillary, the reservoir for all the fluid ingredients the body may need. For such purposes it can be compared with the liver, a reservoir for all the building materials. The spleen is the reservoir for the raw materials which liver and all the other organs use.

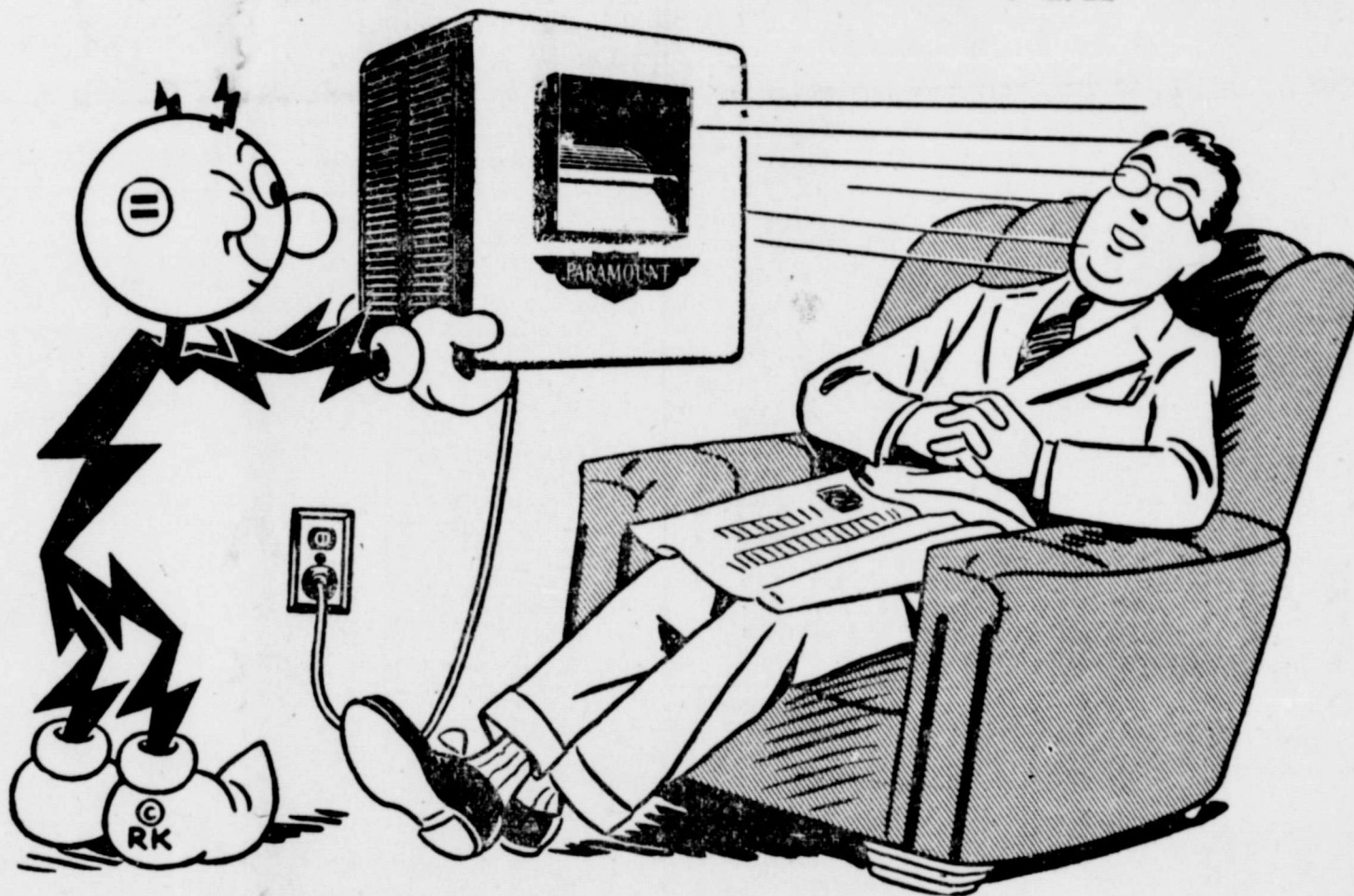

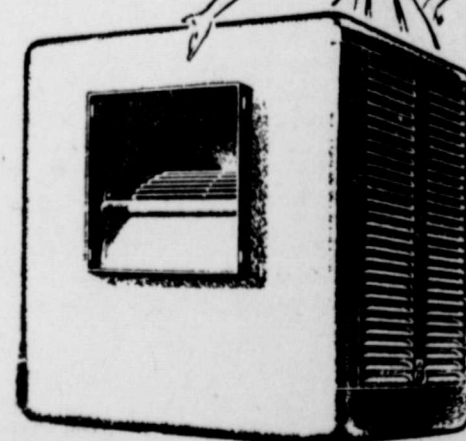

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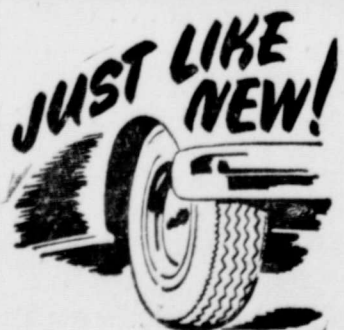
