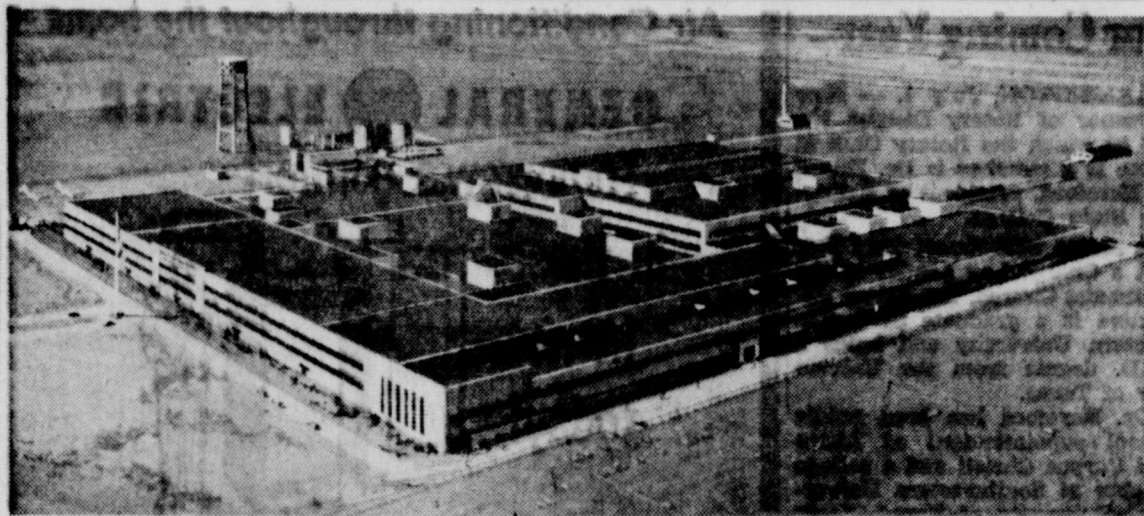


GM Builds New 'Two-Way' Plant in Texas



Construction work has begun on the new General Motors "dual purpose" plant (above) at Arlington, Texas, where GM's Buick-Oldsmobile-Pontiac Assembly Division will build a Grumman-designed airplane for the United States Navy and assemble passenger cars simultaneously. The flexible layout of the plant will permit combined aircraft-automotive operations or it can be converted in a matter of days to either

total aircraft or total automotive production, depending upon military requirements. The "dual purpose" plant idea was first proposed a year ago by C. E. Wilson, GM president, as a means of maintaining strong military and civilian production levels without disruption of plant facilities or working forces. Most of the Buick, Oldsmobile and Pontiac cars produced in the Arlington plant will be for distribution in Texas.

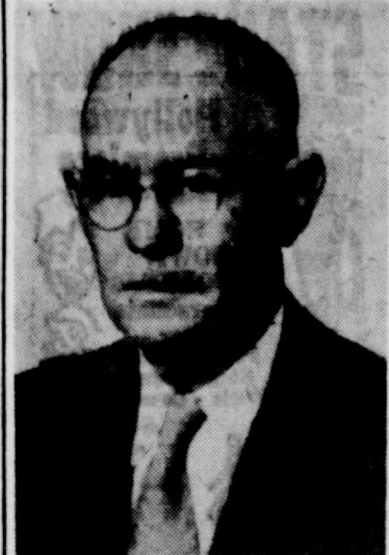

Rotary District Has New Leader For Coming Year

ARLINGTON, July 1. — New governor of Rotary District No. 186 of which the Rotary Club of Cisco is a member is Dr. Ernest H. Hereford, president of Arlington State College.

A native west-Texan from Tow and a Charge Lay Leader in the Methodist Church, the Rotary executive is a graduate of Southwestern University and holds a Ph.D. degree from the University of Texas.

Dr. Hereford has been public school superintendent at Llano and Corpus Christi and a college teacher at Southwestern University, University of Texas, North Texas State College, and Texas College for Women.

He is a former president of Del Mar College at Corpus Christi and an ex-dean of Hockaday School for Girls in Dallas. He has been president of Arlington State College since 1946.

The new governor is the father of two children and has three grandchildren. His Rotary Ann is the former Ruth Barnett of Llano. The couple was married in 1916.

A Rotarian of 20 years experience, Dr. Hereford is noted for a keen sense of humor and a dislike for long speeches. When he pays his official visit to the Cisco club, members can be assured they will hear an address that will not wear them out.

The new governor announces that goals for the district this year will be four-fold: (1) Better Rotary education for local clubs; (2) more Rotary members and more new clubs in the district; (3) special stress on vocational and international services; and (4) 100 per cent participation in the Paul Harris Foundation fund.
