Farm Conditions Are Improved In Eastern Section

Farm activity over the state was fitted into a mixture of warm cold, clear, cloudy, wind, dusty, rainy weather — all within the past week. Light to heavy rains were received over the eastern third of the state. Soil moisture conditions already were reasonable favorable over much of that area, but this additional rain will be very beneficial to growing crops, particularly along the lower coast and in the lower valley.

Most of the western two-thirds of the state continued dry. The cold front which moved across the state late in the week lowered

temperatures abruptly with freezing temperatures on the morning of the 22nd extending to a line below Del Rio, about San Antonio and south of Lufkin. It is too early to fully appraise losses but damage to peaches and plums was expected to be light.

Strong southerly winds before, and chilling north winds after the cold front moved downstate whipped up clouds of dust and caused serious erosion in the northwest. Wheat on the high plains was damaged by the blowing sand but the extent of damage is still uncertain. Farmers in that area were chiseling, rotary hoeing and harrowing but these control measures were only partially effective.

The strong winds further depleted the already short supply of surface moisture. North Texas Wheat was making good to very good development and supplying considerable grazing. Cotton planting continued active in the lower valley and many early planted fields were up to a uniform stand. Light rain at the end of the period will provide moisture to germinate recent plantings.

Irrigated and non-irrigated commercial vegetables in the lower valley and coastal bend were helped by the light general rains over the week-end. Lower valley irrigation water supplies continued scarce. Light weekend rains also benefited growing crops in the winter garden.

Winter grass, small grains and clovers continued to develop over

the eastern third of the State. Cattle and calves were gaining weight in that area as the surplus supply spring grasses increased. Small grains in north Texas were supplying good feed.

Light rain over most western and southwestern counties may start new feed when temperatures moderate but much more moisture is needed to maintain development. Heavy supplemental feeding was necessarily continued over most of the western two-thirds of the State. Chilling winds caused some shrinkage to unprotected stock. Cattle and sheep marketing was heavy.

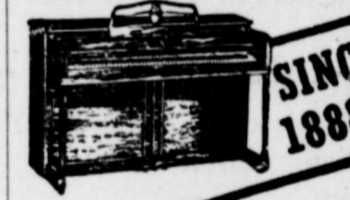
