Vets Questions And Answers

Q — I started training as an accountant under the Korean GI Bill, but I'm afraid I'm in the wrong field. I know I'll have to make my one-and-only change of course, but I want to be reasonably sure it'll be the right change. Could I get VA vocational counseling to help me?

A — Yes. You may apply for counseling on the same application form you use for requesting a change of course.

Q — I want to go to college under the Korean GI Bill to take courses in a variety of fields. They wouldn't lead to a degree or to any sort of objective; they're just courses I've always wanted to study. Would I be permitted to do this under the GI program?

A — No. Under the law, your training program must lead to a single, identifiable educational,

professional or vocational objective. You would not be permitted to take courses that do not lead to such an objective.

Q — My wife and I both are World War II veterans. May we buy a business together, with a GI business loan, and thereby increase the amount which may be guaranteed? It would not be a real estate loan.

A — Yes. However, the guaranty may not exceed 50 percent of the loan, up to \$4,000, which is the maximum for your combined business loan guarantees.

Q — May a seller charge me more for a house that it has been appraised for by the VA, if I buy it with a GI loan?

A — No. Under the law, the purchase price may not exceed the reasonable value determined by VA appraisal. It is illegal to pay more.
