| The Panhandle of Texas became blanketed with the biggest snowfall of the season Sunday as a major storm moved through the region dumping 5 inches of snow in the SpearmanGruver area. <br> The snow was one of the "wettest" on record, and melted out to , 48 inches of liquid moisture. <br> Snow began falling in 6:30 a. m.
