The Phillips Blackhawks defeated the pearman Lynx $49-43$ in a District 1-AA hampionship game at Phillips Tuesday ight, but fans were treated to one of he finest displays of sportsmanship and asketball that this writer has ever witessed.
The Blackhawks jumped into an early - lead and maintained this lead until alf-time, when it was cut to 2 points, $3-21$. Their big boy, Jarnigan, had pree fouls the first half, and with 14 inutes and 17 seconds left in the ball ame (early in the third quarter) he reeived his fourth foul. As soon as Jarigan left the game, the Hawks jumped hto a quick 12 point lead. However, they ut this lead to four points, at the end f the third quarter. In the fourth quar r, Jarnigan was put back into the ame, and lasted only one play when he eceived his 5th foul. With four mintes and 12 seconds left on the clock, nd Jarnigan fouled out, the Lynx pulld within one point, $40-39$ of the Blackawks. The Lynx fans could smell vicpry, but the Hawks simply carried the ame to the Lymx, and jumped into a uick 8 point lead with 2 field goals, nd 4 three throws. Both teams were uperb, their coaches displayed the ery finest poise, and basketball fans fft the game with nothing but praise or these teams.
Although the Lynx game plan went xactly as expected, most fans thought hat the Lynx could handle Phillips if hey could control the big boy Jarnigan. ut, Spearman played the game perectly, they just couldn't defeat the awks. This newspaper has nothing but raise for Coach Simpson and the Philps coach for such a game. It is so eldom in this day and time, that oung men can receive praise from any ource. But the boys on theSpearman yam, and the Phillips team, along ith their coaches and school officials, host certainly are to be congratulated or this fantastic evening of "sportshanship and determination."
