## 'Chico' critical after gunshot

| LOS ANGELES (AP) - Comedian Freddie Prinze, the 22 -year-old star of the hit television series "Chico and the Man," was in critical condition today with a bullet wound in the head following an apparent suicide at- <br> tempt, police said. Lt. Dan Cook sald Prinze had been despondent Thursday night and that several friends and his psychiatrist were in his apartment trying to cheer him up when the shot was fired. <br> "All of a sudden, he reached down into the sofa, pulled out an automatic pistol, and shot himself in the head, Cook said. <br> Cook said a note was found but he would not reveal the contents. <br> Richard Green, administrator at the nearby UCLA Medical Center, said Prinze was listed in "serious to said Prinze was critical condition." <br> "He is not in surgery," Green said. "We have admitted him to one of our intensive care units. <br> Green said Prinze arrived at the hospital's emergency room at 4:06 a.m. and a team of doctors immediately went to work on him. |
