56 Scouts Enroll For Third Camping Period At Mitre Peak

MITRE PEAK GIRL SCOUT CAMP—This Permian Basin Area Girl Scout Camp, situated high in the Davis Mountains 10 miles north of Alpine, Monday opened its third two-weeks camping period with 56 West Texas girls enrolled.

Effects of the flash floods which washed the camp grounds and vicinity about 10 days ago fast are being erased as damages to camp facilities are repaired. Upwards of nine inches of rain were gauged at the campsite during a three-day period.

Despite the heavy moisture, camp activities were not disrupted materially, and Girl Scouts who ended their stay at the camp Saturday reported a "wonderful time."

Mrs. J. J. Black of Midland, camp director, termed the heavy rains a "wonderful experience" for the campers.

Roads Are Open
The swinging bridge across the creek bed which bisects the camp property has been repaired, as have damages to buildings and other facilities. The road leading to the camp at the foot of majestic Mitre Peak again is in fair condition, and scores of automobiles traveled it this weekend. The road was impassable several days following the recent floods. Mountain trails also are being cleared and opened for hikes through the area.

The days are pleasant and the nights are cool in this mountain retreat, and the campers are enjoying the fine climate to the utmost.

The Girl Scouts this year are enjoying a new facility—a large and well-equipped cook-out pavilion, which is being used to an excellent advantage. Other improvements also are in evidence this season.

Mort Facilities Needed
"The main thing we need right now," Mrs. Black stated, "is more and larger facilities to take care of approximately twice as many Scouts as we now can accommodate.

"Our waiting list is too lengthy and we are forced to turn down the applications of too many girls each year because of limited facilities. Maybe we can accept more campers next year. I hope so."

This is the fourth season for the popular Mitre Peak Camp.

French Pilots, U. S. Planes Step Up Raids On Vietminh

HANOI, INDOCHINA—(AP)—The French Union Air Force, bolstered by American-supplied planes, is putting on the biggest aerial assault of the bitter six-year war in Indochina in an attempt to permanently destroy the Communist-led Vietminh's main supply lines with Red China.

Fighters and B-36 bombers daily range far outside the French defense bastion in the Red River delta to plaster the highways leading to China.

Bearing the brunt of the attacks is Colonial Route No. 3, running northward from Hanoi to Cao Bang, 18 miles from the border of Kwangsi Province of China.

Also being hard hit is Colonial Route No. 1, running northeastward from Hanoi to Langson, 10 miles from the Chinese frontier.

Route 2 is the favorite supply line of the Vietminh, who use hundreds of camouflaged, American and Russian supplies to their forces concentrated outside the Red River delta.

The Vietminh have built scores of underground garages as refuges for their transport from the devastating air attacks.

The French repeatedly have ripped out all spans of the highways to China and with high explosive bombs torn big gaps in the roads. To repair these and try to keep war supplies moving, the Vietminh use hundreds of thousands of coolies.

Bombers and fighters are making the Vietminh pay heavily for their attempts to move supplies by sampans and junks on rivers and streams in North Tonkin.

The French Air Force goes in heavily for the use of napalm bombs "whenever the objective justifies it." Napalm usually is showered upon villages in which Vietminh units are entrenched. Heavy, high-explosive bombs are used to blast away at enemy-controlled highways.

French pilots report they have never encountered any air opposition from the Vietminh, or seen any planes that could be identified as Chinese or Russian aircraft.

American-supplied bombs dropped by the French often fall within a few miles of the Chinese border, but the French take every precaution to make sure that the frontier is not violated.

Fighters and bombers hitting the Vietminh don't have much to worry about unless they fly extremely low. The Vietminh haven't used any heavy anti-aircraft guns—if they have any—but they have made hits with machine-gun fire or other light weapons.

The French Union Air Force is estimated to have received more than 200 planes of all types from the U. S. since the American military assistance program started two years ago.

Dizziness Common In Disease That Causes Noises In Ears

An extremely common complaint of older people is a buzzing, ringing or hissing sound, known technically as tinnitus in one or both ears.

Not only is it uncomfortable to have noises in the ears, but it also causes a good deal of anxiety. Judging by letters received, people who have this unpleasant symptom would do almost anything to get rid of it.

Far and away the most common cause is a condition known as Meniere's disease. At the beginning of this peculiar condition, the sounds likely are to be in one ear only and associated with mild impairment in hearing. The disease often is associated with spells of dizziness, and indeed when severe, people sometimes fall and injure themselves.

In at least some forms of Meniere's disease, the cause is believed to be a drop in the deep portion of the ear called the inner ear, or labyrinth. This dropical condition accumulation of fluid—often does not develop in young people, but from the age of 45 on is increasingly common. Why it should come at all is not known.

One or both ears may be involved. The attacks of dizziness may bother patients more than the ringing in the ears or loss of hearing. In

many cases the attacks of dizziness become less and less frequent and severe after the first few years.

Some patients who drink a lot of fluids find that an attack comes on a few hours afterwards—probably because of the increased accumulation of fluid in the labyrinth. This has given a clue leading to the use of some forms of treatment aimed at cutting down the intake of fluids or removing excess fluids from the body.

Surgery In Severe Cases

Several medical treatments have been tried. Surgery also is employed with success in some cases and not in others. Surgical treatment, however, is usually reserved for the most severe cases.

Unless people fall and hurt themselves as a result of dizziness, Meniere's disease is more annoying and uncomfortable than it is dangerous. It does not interfere too much with activities or bodily functions, but often does lead to increasing hardness of hearing. Eventually there is a reduction in the noises.

She Tutored Japan's Crown Prince

NEW YORK—(NEA)—In these modern times, one of the most exciting and extraordinary adventures that could befall an American woman would be that of acting as tutor to the Crown Prince of Japan.

In the mysterious, innermost of the Imperial Court, this woman would see unprecedented, history-making changes.

It's an adventure that actually did befall one American woman, a Quaker named Elizabeth Gray Vining. For four years, dating from October, 1948, she guided Prince Akihito's education, both in private lessons and in a classroom.

She saw him grow from a chubby, round-faced boy into a handsome, poised young man. And for him, she opened windows on a new way of life.

In a recent visit to New York, Mrs. Vining talked about her adventure, and her royal pupil, with obvious delight and pride. The delight was for the four years she had spent with the Japanese people; the pride was for the Prince.

The first question I'm always asked," she said, smiling, "is how I happened to go to Japan. Well, it came about because the Emperor himself wanted a tutor for his son. It was an unprecedented step for him to take, since other people, by custom, are in charge of his son's education. But the Emperor's request was the first of many such

hito to occur in Japan since the war.

"All of this may not seem unusual to Americans, but to the Japanese it was a drastic departure from custom to have an American woman in charge of Prince Akihito's education."

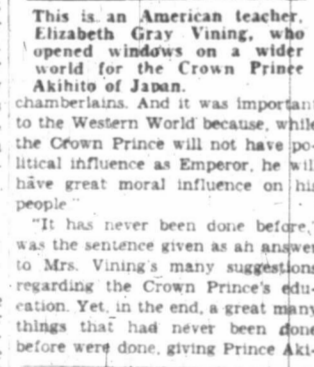
"Usually, every detail of the royal education, as well as every detail in the Prince's life, is handled by the Emperor's courtiers."

When she came away from Japan to return home, Mrs. Vining brought with her an affection for Japan that makes her regard it as a kind of second home. She also brought, as the gift of a grateful Japanese government, the Third Order of the Sacred Crown. Only imperial princesses receive the first and second orders.

What was the end of the great adventure?

"I had seen a broken and bewildered nation pick itself up from its ashes, make an about-face seldom, if ever, equaled in history, and start a new life in a new direction with determination and vigor."

"I had been asked to open windows onto a wider world for the Crown Prince. Through windows, whichever way they face, come light and light, I thought, is good."

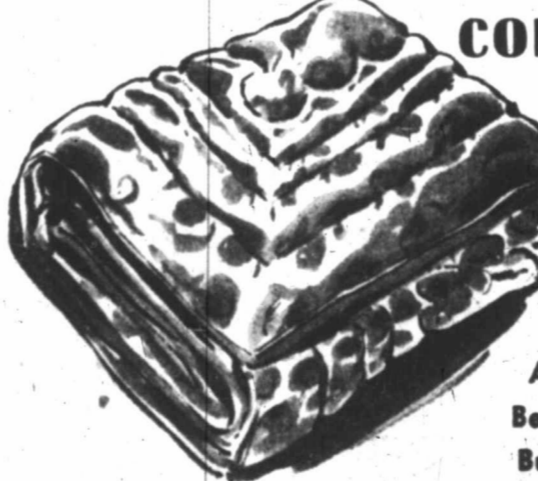
