## Old Volume Reveals 1914 Santa Letters

Clifford Crow brought in a clipping from an issue of the Brownwood Bulletin which was reprinting letters to Santa Claus originally printed in the Blanket Signal, published in 1914
Included was one with his name, which read as follows:
"Dear Santa Claus: I am a very little boy and please don't forget me. I want a rubber ring and some rattlers to play with. You need not bring me anything to eat, as I have no teeth. Your new friend, Clifford Smith Crow.'
Crow says "I was only three months old at the time. I was a smart little fellow to write a letter like that, wasn't I?!'
Also in the paper was a letter from Clifford's older brother, Wilmot (Red) Crow. He was three years old and his letter read as follows:
"Dear Santa: I am a good little boy, three years old, and I want you to bring me a pair of overalls like papa's, some building blocks, and all kinds of good things to eat. Your little friend, Wilmot Smith Crow.'
