The petition, which contained 567 signatures, asked that a bond election be called in the city of Big Spring bef ore allowing the con- struction of a large aircraft hangar on the former Webb AFB property. From the information we have received from these people, it appears that a a ot of false informaunity has been spread in the community of the hangarar."
