The inflammation of the thin membrane that covers the eyeball and inner eyelidthe conjunctiva--can be serious or not, b
optometrist to determine the treatment needed.
If the cause is the chlorine in the swimming pool or an allergy to pollen or even dust, rest and eye drops are usually enough to clear up the irritation. Conjunctivitis is not contagious.
But the problem is caused by bacteria or viruses, it is highly contagious. Antibiotic treatment may be advised. To limit the spread of infection, avoid touching or rubaing hee eye. If hetere is a discharge,
wipe it away with a tisue. Separate your washcloths and towels from the family laundry. Don't use eye makeup or contact lenses, which can spread the infection to the other eye. Notify the eye doctor if the redness gets worse or if vision is blurred.
