RICKART, <br> Market Correspondent. <br> PIG CLUBS FOR BOYS AND GIRLS. <br> Training in Growing and Fattening Hogs Is the Purpose. <br> Training the boys and girls on the farms in the fine art of growing and fattening hogs is one of Uncle Sam's latest applications of the club idea. This work is being carried on by Bradford Knapp's farmers' co-operative department, through the bureau of animal industry. <br> It has been in progress only about two years, but during that time remarkable results have been achieved by the young members of these clubs, particularly in the South. In Louisiana last year there were ninety-seven hogs at the State Fair, and the grand champion Duroe sow in this lot was raised by one of the boy members of a pig club. At one county fair in that state last year all the prizes for hogs were taken by club members. <br> This year the bureau has started the club work in Alabama, ten counties entering and offering prizes in addition to those regularly given by the state and county fairs.
