The latest round in the Hill-Robinson controversy ended
in June when a civil suit, file dy grandson Robert Asston
"Boot" Hill accusing Robinson of causing the death of John Hill, was dismissed. The suit, plus Robert hill's refusal to deed his mother's
grave plot to Robinson, destroyed the relationship bet ween the two, says Robinson, "Well, he wanted some great big amount of money (for Wel, he wanted some great big amount of money (for
the plot) to pay off what they owed in court," Robinso said. "I told him I wouldn't do the Sorthar's whet I came to the conclusion he just wasn't
worth fooling with. 1 m fairly conviced Boot is not worthy of our sympathy.
