WEATHER HARD GUESS

curately predict the kind of weather that will occur over an area of several States within the next twenty-four hours.

He doesn't gamble his reputation in one prediction, but every prediction he makes leaves its mark. Each forecast he makes is checked against actual conditions; his batting average figured compared with the averages of his colleagues and of those practicing forecasters who are after his job, and marking down in the records of the central Weather Bureau here in Washington.

To insure uniformity of rating, the Weather Bureau has prepared a carefully drafted list of words for use in forecasts, each of which has a definite meaning—a system which prevents hedging. For instance, if the weather man says "Rain," the records for the day for which he is predicting must show precipitation of at least 1-100th of an inch.

The weatherman can use the words "possibly" or "probably" if he thinks that describes the situation, but if he says "probably showers" or "possibly northwest winds," and the showers and winds do not occur his prediction in these respects is counted as a failure and his average takes a slump.

Getting Black Marks

Now, the thing works both ways. If the weatherman says a certain condition will occur and it doesn't he gets a black mark. On the other hand, if he fails to say a certain condition will occur, and it does, he gets a black mark too.

This particularly hard on the weatherman in winter, with respect to cold waves. A cold wave in the precise terminology of the Bureau, is a specified drop in temperature within twenty-four hours. It must occur within thirty-six hour period following the forecast. The amount of drop specified depends upon the location of the cold wave, and the time of year. It averages 20 degrees.

With the northern border virtually unprotected by outposts to report the advance of cold waves, the weathermen are often caught unawares by a sharp cold snap which they failed to foresee. Accordingly, their averages go down.

Other conditions which must be forecast are frost, high winds and floods. About the only things the forecaster is not expected to predict are tornadoes. The Weather Bureau stopped predicting them some years ago, after they had frightened most of the Mississippi Valley population half to death with predictions that failed to verify.

All predictions and forecasts are checked in the central office. They are compiled for the individual forecaster, for his district office and for their respective components, such as weather temperature etc. The average for the whole forecasting force over a number of years has been 88 per cent accurate, the weather for six days out of seven correctly predicted. But this average is obtained by balancing forecasts made in difficult localities with those in easy localities.
