## Sub-Soil Moisture Is Important to Next Year's Crop

OUR SOILS WILL HOLD APPROXIMATELY 2 INCHES OF MOISTURE PER 1 FOOT OF SOIL

In October and November of 1955 this area received from 6 to 11 inches of rain. It was this moisture that contributed a great deal to our ex cellent crops this year.

IN 1956 WE RECEIVED VERY LITtLE FALL MOISTURE THE SUB.SOIL MOISTURE NOW IS VERY LOW

According to rainfall records, we can expect very little moisture in this trea before April or May.
Irrigation farmers should plan now to replace needed subsoil moisture prior to planting. This means that a farmer with soil 4 feet deep should apply at least 8 inches of moisture.

Most soils in the Terry Soil Conservation District are from 4 to 6 fee deep. This means that farmers should apply from 8 to 12 inches of water on their land prior to planting.

THE TERRY SOIL CONSERVATION SERVICE WILL ASSIST FARMERS IN DETERMINING SOIL DEPTHS AND AMOUNTS OF WATER TO APPLY

The farmer should start watering enough to cover all his land with a heavy application of water, then if necessary during the summer he can cut back his watering in accordance with the plant needs and the amount of water that can be pumped.
