## AgriLife putting designer potatoes on the menu to boost consumption

Dr. Creighton Miller, AgriLife Research potato breder from College Station, recently conducted the Texas A\&M Potato Breeding and Variety Development
Program field day at the farm Program field day at the farm of cooperator Bruce
south of Springlake.
"Potatoes are an important delivery system for nutrients to humans," Miller said. "The average consumption in the U.S. is 113 pounds per year ${ }_{\text {per person. But overall potato }}$ consumption in the U.S. has generally declined somewhat.
"So what we are doing now is developing unique varieties is dat have a tendency to appeal that he a e tendency to appeal
to the younger set with high income who are willing to try something different," he said.

"We are always interested in new and improved red va-
rieties and russet varieties, but there are some other types that have become more interesting lately," Miller said. One type is a small potato,

ies with a heavy set of small potatoes.

This year's effective tax rate would imposes the same total taxes as last year if you compare properties taxed in both years.
