NOTICE OF COMPARABLE TAX RATES
AND REVENUES

The legislature has enacted a statute on school funding to comply with a court mandate enforcing the state constitution. Under prior statutes (SB 1) the tax rate for last year provides $\$ 6,530$ per student in state and local revenues. Under this statute (SB 351) that same rate now provides $\$ 5,715$ per student in state and local revenues.

State law only requires a minimum tax rate of $\$ .7820$ for county education districts. State law does not require a school district to adopt additional taxes. Neither does state law require a school district to adopt a tax rate that maximizes the receipt of state funds.

The board of trustees of the Sands CISD School District hereby gives notice that it is considering the adoption of a tax rate of .48 that will provide $\$ 5,866$ per student in state and local revenues

In another bowl beat egg whites to form soft peaks; fold into cheese mixture. Pour into prepared tart shell. Bake in 350 -degree oven 50 to 60 minutes until lightly browned, puffy and set. Cool on rack. cherries with jelly. Garnish with almonds. Serve immediately.

Makes 8 servings
TART SHELL: In large bowl mix 1 cup flour, 1 tablespoon sugar and $1 / 4$ teaspoon salt. Add 6 tablespoons cold butter, cut into chunks. Cut in with pastry blender until mixture resembles coars meal. Beat 1 egg yolk with 2 tablespoons ice water. Add to flour mixture. Mix with fork and gather into a ball. Roll out on lightly floured surface into 11 -inch circle. Fit into $91 / 2$-inch tart pan with press firmly against side of pan, allowing pastry to extend slightly above top. Refrigerate 10 minutes. Meanwhile, heat oven to 425 degrees. Prick tart shell all over with fork and line with aluminum foil. Fill with pie weights, dried beans or rice. Bake 14 minutes. Remove foil and weights; continue to bake 10 to 15 minutes longer until lightly browned and cooked through. Cool on rack.

CHERRY-MASCARPONE TRIFLE
3 cups frozen Northwest pitted dark sweet
cherries, divided
$1 / 4$ cup cream sherry
$11 / 2$ cups milk
3 egg yolks
$1 / 2$ teaspoon vanilla
1 pound cake ( $10 \% / 4$ to 12 ounces), thawed if frozen
1 container ( 7 ounces) or 1 cup Wisconsin
Mascarpone cheese
Marinate cherries in sherry. Refrigerate while preparing custard. Combine milk, yolks and sugar in small saucepan; cook and stir bite-size pieces and place in 6 -to 8 -cup glass bowl. Drain and reserve $3 / 4$ to 1 cup marinated cherries; spoon remaining cherries and marinade over cake. Reserve 1 cup custard; pour remaining custard over cake. Cover surface with waxed paper or plastic wrap; refrigerate 2 to 4 hours until completely chilled. Completely cool remaining custard and gently stir into cheese in bowl; spread over
top of trifle. Sprinkle with crushed biscuits and gamish wit top of trifle. Sprink
reserved cherries.

## CHOCOLATE FONDUE

 AND FROZEN CHERRIES1 bag ( 16 ounces) frozen Northwest pitted dark sweet cherries
6 ounces semisweet chocolate*
1 tablespoon butter
2 tablespoons half-and-half
2 tablespoons kirsch, or almond-flavored liqueur**
1 cup finely chopped toasted hazelnuts
1 cup finely chopped toasted hazelnuts, optional
Partially thaw cherries by placing in refrigerator 15 to 30 minutes. In small saucepan over very low heat melt chocolate and butter. Stir in half-and-half and liqueur. Pour chocolate mixture into fondue pot; keep warm. Serve with partially thawed cherries and long picks or fondue forks. Dip cheries into sauce then into hazelnuts. Eat immediately.
