New Jersey Governor Takes Decisive Lead On Early Ballots When Illinois Delegates Join His Camp--.No Nomina tion Yet Made for Vice-President-..Adjourn ment Taken Until Tonight.

Baltimore, July 2:-Receiving 990 votes on the forty-sixth ballot, Governor Woodrow Wilson of New Jersey was nominated for president of the United States by the national democratic convention early this afternoon.

The convention adjourned antil nine o'clock tonight without nominating a vice-president.
