Destroyed Off West Coast Of Africa

London, 4:12 p. m., August 27. - The Kaiser Wilhelm der Grosse has been sunk off the west coast of Africa by the British cruiser, High Flyer
Winston Churchill, first lord of the admiralty, annoounced the sinking of the Kaiser Wilhelm der Grosse before the House of Commons this afternoon.. He said:
"The Admiralty has just received intelligence that the German armored merchant cruiser, the Kaiser Wilhelm der Grosse of 14,000 tons and 'armed with ten four inch guns was sunk by His Majesty's ship, High Flyer, off the west coast of Africa. This vessel has been interfering with traffic between this country and the Cape, and is one of the few German armed auxiliary cruisers which succeeded in getting to sea.
"The survivors were landed before the vesse sank. The High Flyer had one man killed and three wounded."

The Kaiser Wilhelm der Grosse was one of the palatial steamers of the North German Lloyd line. It was on this vessel that he late Mayor Gay nor was shot as he was about to sail for Europe.

It is officially announced at St. Retersburg that the Russian advance in Prussia is proceeding with iresistible force. It has heretofore been stated that the objective point of the main Russian army for the present is Posen in German, Poland. The Germans are represented as having retired o Osterode in East Prussia.

A merchant arriving in London from Berlin is credited with the statement that trains are bringing many refugees to Berlin from Koenigsburg, which city he claimed civilians had been advised to leave.

Diplomatic relations betweèn Austria and Japan apparently have been ormally severed. A dispatch direct from Tokio states that the Austrian Ambassador Muller Der Scenteyorgy has been recalled

A blockade of the leased territory of Kiau Chow has been declared by he Japanese whose warships shelled a small island off the coast. The island was not defended. This information comes from Tsing Tau. The same correspondent states that as far as can be observed the Japanese had not et landed any troops.

The Japanese Minster of Justice, Yukio Ozaki, announces that the hostilities in the China and Japan seas will end with the capture of Kiau Chow, when Japan will become spectator instead of participant in the war.

He adds, howéver, that if the Germans should prove a menace to peace in the South Seas, Japan weuld consult with Great Britain and might coperate in driving the enemy of the allies out of the Orient.

Keen interest continues in the attitude that Italy will eventually as Ki., A Rome correspondent of the London Times says that Germany an Austria are bringing great pressure to bear and are offering Italy induc ment to join them. Newspaper dispatches represent the italian people more favorable to a war against Austria. It is to be noted, however, hese reports lack official confirmation.
dispatch from Kraguye Batz, Servia, says that the Austrian army ha uated the Sanjak of Novipazar.
The Germans have occupied the French cites of Lille, Valencienne nd Roubaix according to a dispatch from Ostend, Belgium, which passed hrough the hands of the censor at Condon. All three cities are situated within a few miles of the Belgian frontier and Lille is strongly fortified. Exact knowledge of this awaits official confirmation.

Early dispatches from Ostend quoted a Belgian officer as authority for statement that the allies had decided not to defend Lille, and that it evacuation by the French troops was announced by the mayor Tuesday

A wireless dispatch direct from Berlin early today brought the official announcement that all the forts at Namur had fallen before the Germans who also had captured Longwy.
