Loindon, Oct. 29.- From west and east Ger man reverses are reported. Germany acknowl the great battle in Flanders she is silent. The bes information available indicates that notwith standing dauntless attacks and heavy losses th invaders are further from the coast than when th battle began.

The one great factor on which the allies build their hopes of an eventful triumph apparently, $i$ according to their information, beginning to tell the almost inexhaustible supply of men that may be drawn from the vast reaches of the British and Russian empire ion ent at Petrograd estimates the Russian emperor, army at eight million men.
