Cataracts: Common
In People Over 60 A cataract is a clouding of our eye's lens
that causes loss of vision. The lens consists of water and protein. The protein is arranged in a way that keeps the lens clear and allows light tein may clump together. A small area of the lens begins to cloud and
the and form a cataract. Sometimes 40 -and 50 -year-old people get age-related cataracts, but the condition is usually found in people 60 and older. Since a cataract starts out small with no impact on your vision, you need a chorough eye examination to spot the condition. If the eye care professional dous ind a cataract, surgery is often recommended. In his procedure, your clouded lens is removed and replaced by a clear,
plastic one. Over 15 million cataract surgeries are done each year. Ask your vision care specialist for more information on this condition, how it occurs and the way it is treated. Get your eyes checked every year to spot this and other problems that can develop with age.
