The sheriff's office is planning to equip each of its deputies with a bulletand stab-resistant vest in the near future, while each patrol sergeant's vehicle will be equipped with an automatic heart defibrillator unit.

"Different organizations are giving us money for the vests on our 50-50 match," Sheriff Dale Walker said. "We're doing great on that. I mean, we're already there at 50 percent. We've applied for a grant through the federgovernment for

this...it's a bullet vest and stab vest. They say don't say 'bulletproof' because nothing's bulletproof. But

bullet-resistant. it's Puncture-resistant. We have to match 50 percent of that."

Walker said about \$5,000 has been raised for the vests so far.

Special needs children get big boost

Special to the Herald When the Fraternal Order of Eagles No. 3188 was looking for a beneficiary for its first ever Barbecue Cook-off, it had to look no further than the front row. Landon Sturdivant looked up from the meeting and threw out the Children in Need Fund as a possibility.

The fund is used when West Texas Centers for MHMR can find no other avenue to pay for a child's unexpected need.

"It could be a child who needs a new pair of shoes or can't afford school supplies," said Sturdivant, who is West Texas Center's associate chief executive officer. "It's set up so that there's as little bureaucratic red tape as possible."

West Texas Centers doesn't solicit funds for the program, Sturdivant said. And as a result, the balance has quickly awindled down to a very low balance.

"It's one of those funds that has been totally wiped out," he said. "We have had people who donate on an individual basis, who want to give money to children. But we've never had a major fundraiser for it."

The Eagles Lodge, whose 150 members donate hundreds of thousands of dollars to a number of charities, nationally and in the region stepped up to the plate and gave the fund a boost with the presentation of a \$1,550 following the April 5 barbecue cook-off.

"It was a great kick start to the fund," Sturdivant said.

Although, the Eagles Lodge is a diligent, hard-working fund-raising organization, their organization is a well-kept secret, Lodge Trustee David Baird said. The majority of the group's money is raised at bingo.



"The Eagles try to help children," Baird said. "We'll help anyone who needs help.'

Lodge members wanted to move their fund-raising efforts closer to home, prompting the discussion on a worthy charity, Baird said. When Sturdivant explained the fund, Lodge members unanimously agreed to give all proceeds from the barbecue cook-off to WTCMHMR.

Six cookers prepared almost 160 pounds of meat, Baird said. When it appeared that the demand was going to exceed the supply, more meat went into the pits. Add gallons of tea, trays of cobbler, ice cream donated by Blue Bell, deep pots of beans and huge tubs of potato salad and cole slaw, and no one went away hungry, Baird said.

Judges were Howard County Judge Ben Lockhart, Big spring Councilman Stephanie Horton, Big Spring Police Lt. Terry Chamness and Veterans Administration Medical Center Director Cary Brown.

'We needed some more judges, so we grabbed two innocent looking people," Baird said laughingly.
