**FORMAL SURRENDER IN 10 DAYS
 MANILLA --** Gen. MacArthur estimated today formal surrender be signed in Japan within 10 days.

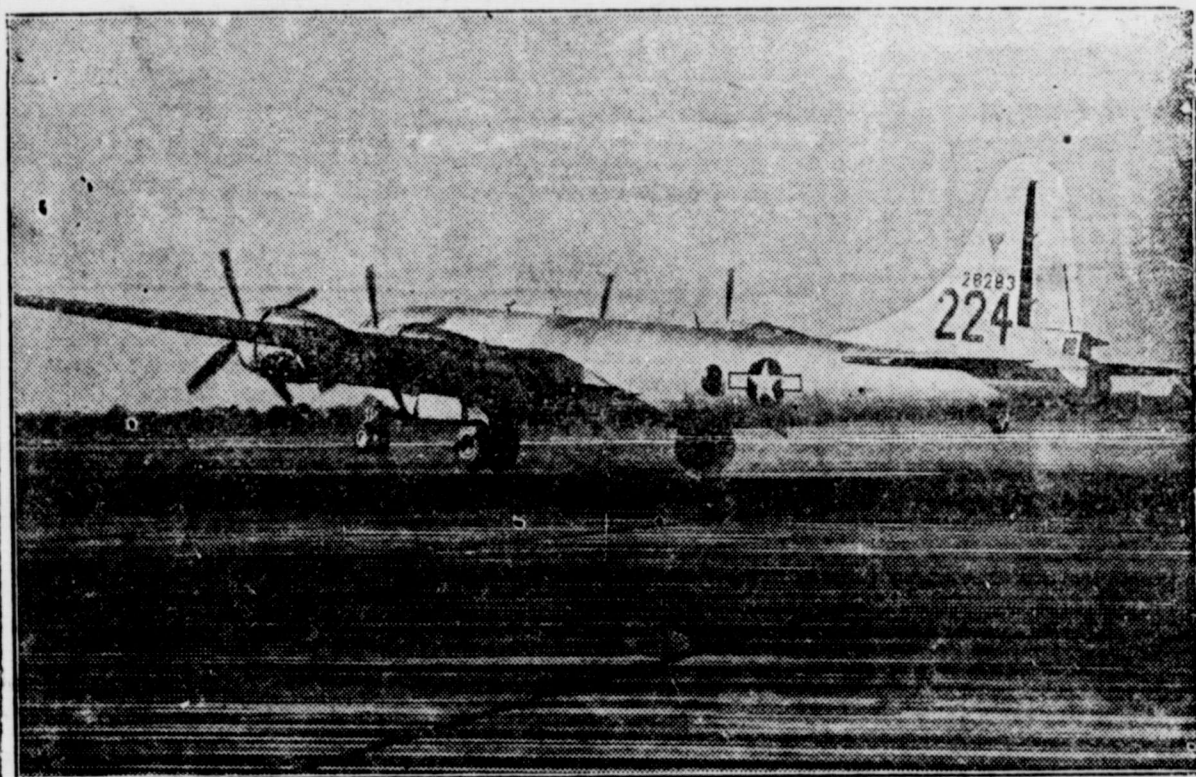
MacArthur's prediction issued as whirlwind surrender conference ended less than day after begun.

Delegates, coldly ignored by Gen. MacArthur himself, given understand U.S. forces will occupy Japan at will Supreme Commander.

U.S. Hdqs. report said top-ranking officers pleased with apparent sincere attitude Japs in providing data needed complete occupation without incident.

Consensus was Japs anxious get out of war, carry out terms Potsdam Declaration.

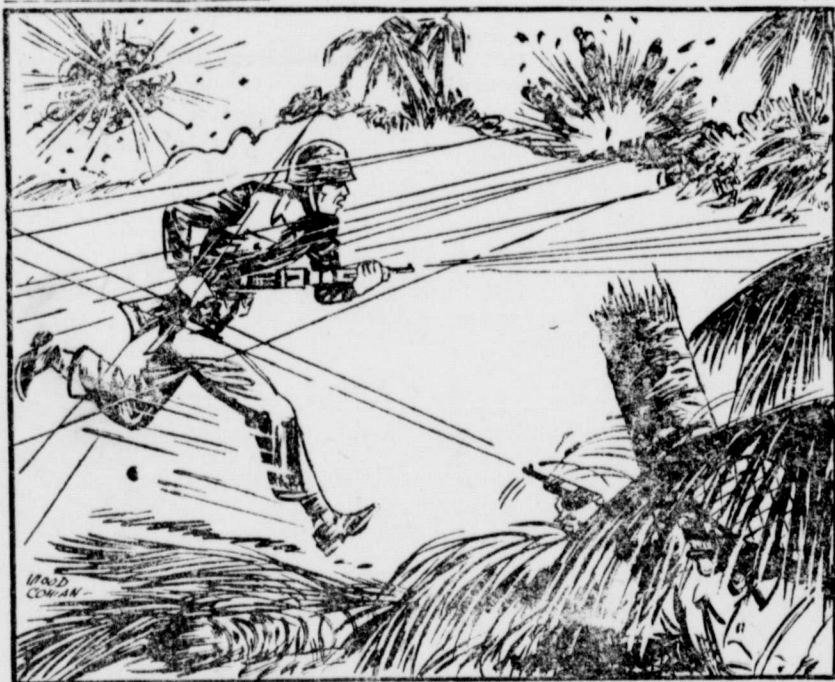
'Stalling', due Japs unfamiliarity with surrender procedure, stunning impact defeat. Unrest, despair said sweeping Japan. Control of military major problem.

LATEST U. S. ARMY B-29 SUPERFORTRESS STARTS FLIGHT—Compare this giant bomber with the fragile little "flying machine" of 1909. The B-29 has a wing span of 141 feet, 3 inches—more than 106 feet wider than the first Army plane—weighs 135,000 pounds, and is driven by four 18-cylinder engines of 2,200 horsepower each. Its speed is rated at more than 300 miles per hour. It carries a bomb load up to 10 tons or more beside an armament of 10 to 12 50-caliber guns. Its wing spread is greater than the length of the runway for the take-off of the first Army plane of 1909.

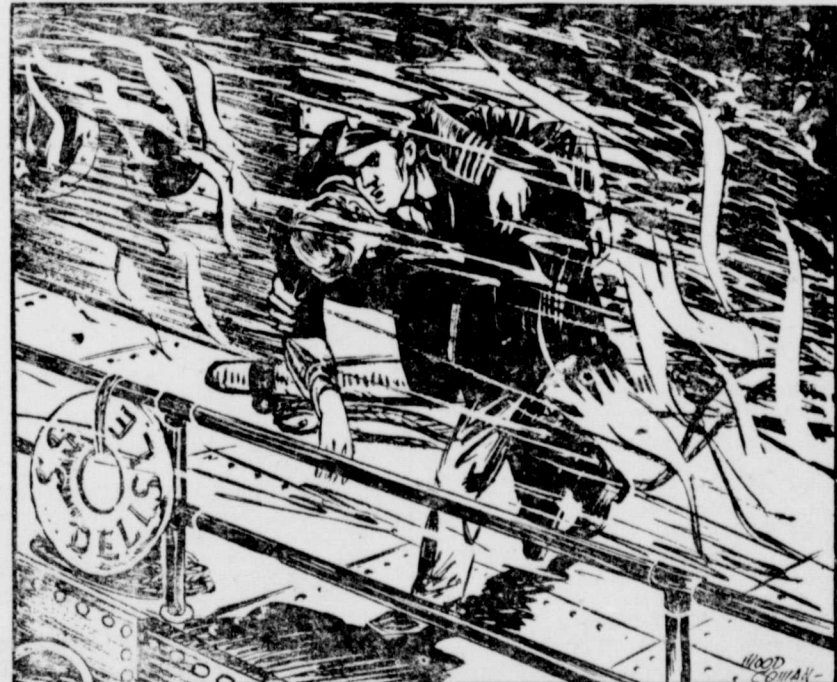
WHO wouldn't buy War Bonds to support men like Pvt. Donald R. Lobaugh, Freeport, Pa.? With his platoon's withdrawal blocked by enemy machine guns, he advanced alone and freed it. Crawling close to the enemy position under heavy fire, he threw a hand grenade and then rushed the Nips, firing as he went. Struck time and again, he killed two of the enemy and forced the others to withdraw before his last fall. The Medal of Honor was awarded him posthumously.

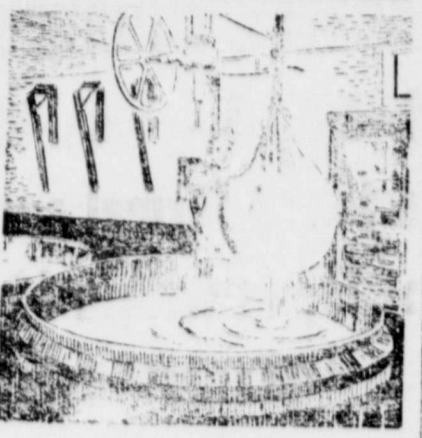

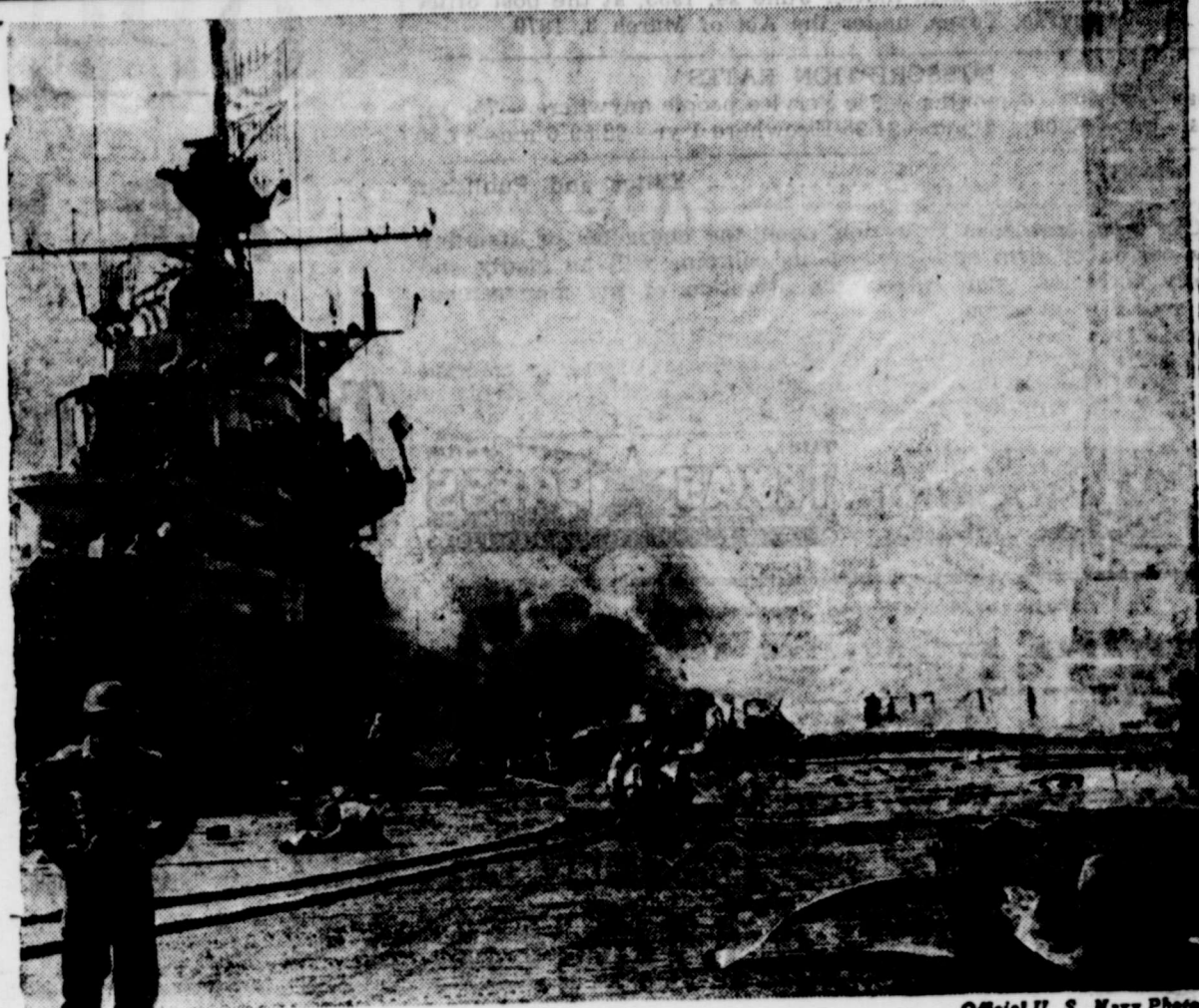

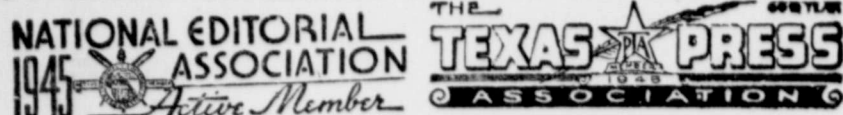

PROCESSED FOODS — Book four blue stamps T2 through X2 good through July 31; Y2 Z2 and A1 through C1 good through Aug. 31; D1 through H1 good through Sept. 30; J1 through N1 good through Oct. 31; P1 through T1 good from Aug. 1 through Nov. 30.

SUGAR — Book four stamp 36 good for five pounds through Aug. 31. Next stamp valid Sept. 1.

SHOES — Book three airplane stamps 1, 2, and 3 good indefinitely. OPA says no plans to cancel any. Airplane stamp 4 valid Aug. 1 and good indefinitely.

GASOLINE — 16-A coupons good for six gallons each through Sept. 21, B-7, B-8, C-7 and C-8 coupons good for five gallons each.

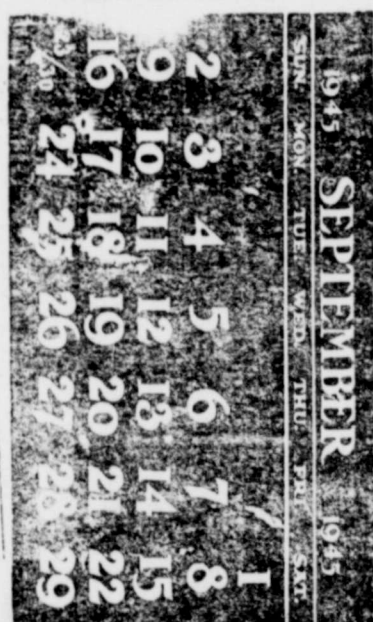
