A district office for the 1960 Census of Population and Housing was opened at Waco, Director James W. Stroud has announced. J. Fred Simon Jr., will be supervisor of the district office and will direct a force of 20 crew leaders and 334 census takers in Bell, Bosque, Coryell, Falls Mc-Lennan and Milam counties.

Nationally there will be 160,-000 eneumerators, 10,000 crew leaders, 400 district supervisors, all temporary workers.

Prior to the census all households will receive an Advance Census Report Form, which gives family chance to assemble information.


