Though many of us enjoy reasonable prosperity, dark clouds have appeared on the much faith that the current administration - or its potential replacements - might fix what ails us.
Historically, the United States economy has actually proven fair-
ly resilient and more than able to withstand huge blows. Having one
rotten sector or failing area has
usually not tipped the nation in usually not tipped the nation into damage outside that area. As a country we've weathered the bursting of the Internet stock bubble, giant corporate scandals less people's retirement funds and the saving and loan scandals of the 1980s. For an actress as talented as she obviously is, it's hard to turn in a stellar performance that captures the awkwardness of being a teen - much less a teen locking horns with Death itself - a feet she pulls off with flying colors.
The Rube Goldberg factor is the film's must eyecatching element. It's never anything as simple as a car swerving across the line and hitting you, or even a regular ol' heart attack. No, for these grudge deaths, the Grim Reaper prefers something a little more elegant.
We watch as several elements are established that stereo is too close to that puddle, those decorative swords are not tightly affixed to that wall, and so forth - and then watch as one minor incident trig gers a chain reaction among all these unrelated circumstances, culminating in someone's head being smashed.
Wong and Morgan are smart to inject the film with gallows humor, which keeps it from becoming oppressively dark. They don't dwell on the gore, either. The deaths happen, and they happen spectacularly - but they also usually happen quickly, without any lingering on the aftermath or bloody leftovers.
Another bright spot for this DVD is the special features. Unlike most movies today, you have to somewhat work to get the Easter eggs out of this film. There are plenty of clues lending themselves to the ultimate demise of previous film characters, helping to sort of wrap-up the franchise in the end.
The film also gives the
viewer a chance to play along, something also rare today. While most discs

will just throw alternate endings on the disc like a late-night diner cook plates your Moons Over My Hammy, again, you have to work for it. The viewer gets to make key decisions in the movie that can either move things along, change the time line (the most entertaining being the demise of Franky Cheeks) or even end it all right then and there.
If you're a fan of the Final Destination franchise, this movie is certainly a step up from FD2 and is a must see/buy. Between the gore and the language, the film earns its Rated-R from the MPAA, but it's not a rough Rated-R by any means.


If you didn't like the first FD movie, you may want to pass this over in favor of something a little less dark, like a Scooby movie or something.
