## Notice to Parents of School Age Children

January is annual census month for Hico Public Schools, and all eligible students must be enumerated by February 1
Children who are now five but will be six on or before Sept. 1 1960, will be listed on the Census Blank as they will be eligible to go to school next term, as are any who are now six whose birthdays were later than Sept. 1, 1959.

## WHO MUST REGISTER:

Those who will be 18 before Sept. 1, 1960, must be left off the blank, but married teenagers are still eligible and should be counted if they live in the Hico District and will not hove reached their eighteenth birthday.
Questions concerning the Census, or if you are not contacted or sent a blank, please call SY 6-4448 or contact someone at the school. Each scholastic means about $\$ 80.00$ to the achool, and it is important that every eligible child is counted. We will appreciate your telling us if some family is being overlooked.
